Sunday Oct. 21st

This day opens with lying at anchor ahead of the crew
went ashore about 9 o'clock on a small boat. Boarded at Smith's
Kiosk. went to see if he could get the boat the things
about for him they agreed to give up all of the property
by paying something for it. So ends this day

Monday Oct. 22nd

This day opens with lying at anchor. Sent 5 men to
fill the baskets & get them on board filled 12 baskets
brought off 8 of them & stored it down. So ends

Tuesday Oct. 23rd

This day opens with lying at anchor. Sent one boat
crew to fill water and the 5 natives but could not get
any for it was salt came on board about 2 o'clock P.M.
5 baskets then went in and filled the others at
7 o'clock A.M. 2 boats & crew went after wood came off
about 8 o'clock P.M. with one boat load could not
get any more. So ends this day

Wednesday Oct. 24th

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed
in getting wood & water. Took 3 boatloads of wood
and 1130 lbs of water. So ends this day

Thursday Oct. 25th

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed
in getting down water and sent the raft to shore
but could not fill it. So ends this day

Friday Oct. 26th

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed
in getting water. Two boats went after wood came back
with one boat load filled & brought off 100 lbs of water.

Saturday Oct. 27th

This day opens with lying at anchor. Sent a small raft
to shore & took it on board about 3 o'clock P.M. Three boats
went after wood about 10 miles off came back about
midnight with one load finished. Storing down water
about 7 o'clock P.M. 370 lbs & 6 loads of wood.

Sunday Oct. 28th

This day opens with lying at anchor part of the crew
on shore most of the day. So ends

Monday Oct. 29th

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed
in getting ready for the boat. About midday A.M. had a boat
from the S.W. took the anchor in the bay and made
all sail heading N.W. Nothing of note in sight.

Tuesday Oct. 30th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S.W. Steaming
by at one the Port. Took heading N.W. with all
sail and watch employed in ship's duty. Sent the
boat in fore top gallant sail & main. So ends
this day.
