This day opens with a light breeze from South steering by it & sails in sight all hands idle at daybreak under short sail So ends this day

Monday Nov 22nd

This day opens with a light breeze from the South at daylight the town about 2 miles off at 9 o'clock with the boat & crew on shore brought off 10 sacks of potatoes 3 barrels & Apples 3.00 & 5 pears for the boat So ends this day

Tuesday Nov 23rd

This day opens with a light breeze from the S & steering by it at about 9 o'clock under short sail a crew on with the boat & second mate. came back with a lighter load of Wood took the lighter back & second mate & boat came off about 4 o'clock. kept along on the Sth tack under short sail So ends this day

Wednesday Nov 24th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the S & steering by it on the South tack with all sail and heading S.W. Nothing in sight

Lat 37-45 S. Long 70-40 W So ends this day

Thursday Nov 25th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the S & steering by it on the South tack with all sail and Watch employed in Ships Duty Nothing in sight Lat 38-40 S Long 71-40 W So ends this day
