

Remarks on Board Bark *Bartholomew* of New Bedford
Friday Dec. 24th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W.
at daylight kept E.S.E. and made about 11 o'clock at which
we had a light breeze from the S.W.
Watch employed in raising the main topmast staysail
Nothing in sight Lat. 33-00. So ends this day

Saturday Dec. 25th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S.W. steering
E.S.E. under short sail at daylight made sail Watch
employed in ships duty nothing in sight
at sunset took in sail and came to the anchor in the
Port Hook heading N.W.

Lat. 33-10 S Long. 24-24 W So ends this day

Sunday Dec. 26th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W. at
daylight kept E.S.E. and made about 11 o'clock
which away calm and at 1 o'clock had a light breeze from
the W. at sunset came to the anchor and shortened sail

Lat. 32-53 S Long. 23-07 W So ends this day

Monday Dec. 27th

This day opens with a light breeze from the N.W. steering
by it in the Port Hook under short sail at daylight
made all sail available employed in ships duty nothing
in sight at sunset shortened sail & went around in
the S.W. took 1000 & 2000 made 10 o'clock in the forenoon

Lat. 32-14 S Long. 22-25 W So ends this day

Tuesday Dec. 28th

This day opens with a light breeze from the N.W. steering
by it in the S.W. took about 1 o'clock at which we hauled to
the S.W. and increasing at daylight. reefed topsails
Watch employed in ships duty nothing in sight Cape &
Hazard made 10 o'clock in the forenoon anchoring in
Lat. 33-00 S Long. 22-00 W So ends this day

Wednesday Dec. 29th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the South about
noon at which we commenced to moderate at daylight took the
reefs with a broad gale & sprang. Watch employed in various
jobs nothing in sight at sunset took in gill & sprang

Lat. 32-25 S Long. 21-27 W So ends this day

Thursday Dec. 30th

This day opens with a light breeze from S.E. steering by it
in the S.W. took at daylight made all sail watch employed
in ships duty nothing in sight at sunset took in light
sails. Lat. 32-10 S Long. 20-02 E So ends this day

Friday Dec. 31st

This day opens with light & variable winds about noon
at which it calmed & fell about 11 o'clock then had a light
breeze from the S.W. steering by it in the S.W. took
Watch employed in ships duty nothing in sight
rove off their fore braces and a new stage tackle put

Lat. 32-31 S So ends this day
