

Remarks for Board Book. Beathan & their Bedford
Saturday Jan 8th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the W. N. W.
Steering by it on Port Tack about 2 o'clock the wind
hauled S. S. W. at daylight kept on & under reefed topsail
& foresail. Watch employed in washing clothes, porpoises and
caught one. At sunset took in foresail and came to the
anchor at 11 P.M. Lat 32-31. Long 13-54. To end this day

Sunday Jan 9th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the S. at daylight
lassed foresail and kept off on S. at 9 o'clock took the reefs
out & used main galliesail & flying jib saw fin backs
& porpoises at sunset shortened sail and came to the anchor
Lat 32-10 S. Long 13-03 To end this day

Monday Jan 10th

This day opens with light variable winds at daylight
made sail and kept on & watch employed in ships
Duty. Nothing in sight about 2 o'clock the wind
a light breeze from S. S. W. at sunset took in light sails
Lat 32-20 S. Long 13-01 To end this day

Tuesday Jan 11th

This day opens with a light wind from the S. at daylight made
sail steering on to the S. S. W. ships steering to the S. S. W. and
went along side of one of them. Ship Quaker from
of S. Johns 22 days from Palau. Bound to Rotterdam reported
had seen 2 boats within 5 of the cape and off of it came around
on the right hand side. Topsails came back and took up the boat
about 4 o'clock brought on board 2 planks and 20 lbs of painted watch
employed in setting up. Nothing in sight shortened sail

Wednesday Jan 12th

This day opens with variable winds & squalls about 9 o'clock
took the S. & topsails steering to N. E. watch employed in
breaking and water and looking for porpoises. Ship saw one
fin back and porpoises at sunset shortened sail
Lat 30-12 S. Long 12-10 To end this day

Thursday Jan 13th

This day opens with a good breeze from S. steering to N. E.
at daylight made sail watch employed in ships duty. Second
made & one boat came rattled down. Put out buoy sign
thing in sight at sunset shortened sail at 12 o'clock went around
Lat 27-22 S. Long 13-03 To end this day

Friday Jan 14th

This day opens with S. & topsails steering by the wind on
the port tack heading at daylight kept off by the wind
made sail saw fin backs & porpoises about 12 o'clock saw
blackfish several & boats. Boat struck a but did not save
but one they went quite to the S. & other 2 boats did not get
near them took the boats up and the fish on deck about 1 o'clock
then kept on & at sunset shortened sail and went
around on Port Tack

Saturday Jan 15th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S. S. W. steering
by it on the Port Tack at daylight made sail and kept
on & watch employed in ships duty. Nothing of note in
sight shortened sail as usual and went around to the W.
Lat 25-24 S. Long 13-53 To end this day
