This day opens with a fine breeze from the S. Steering
N. by W. at daylight made sail at 10 o'clock kept N. by E
Watch employed in various jobs Nothing of note in sight
Sunset Shortened sail and new main topsail hal yards
Lat. 21-44 S Long 68-43 So ends this day

Thursday Feb 11th

This day opens with a fine breeze from South Steering
N. by E. at daylight made sail at 10 o'clock sent down
fore topsail repaired and bent at nothing but black fish
in sight Sunset Shortened sail and came to the wind
on the Western Tack

Lat. 19-35 S Long 69-30 So ends this day
Friday Feb 12th

This day commences with a good breeze from the South Steering
by it on the Western Tack at daylight made sail Steering
W. by N. at 12 o'clock kept N. by E. Nothing in sight of note
Sunset Shortened sail

Lat. 19-07 S Long 69-54 So ends this day
Saturday Feb 13th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the S. Steering
by it on the S. Tack heading E. by S at sunrise made
sail and kept E. Watch employed in Ships Duty
Sunset shortened sail Nothing of note in sight
came to the wind on the S. Tack heading E. by S

Lat. 18-10 S Long 69-54

This day opens with a good breeze from the S. Steering by it
on the Eastern Tack at daylight came around & made sail
kept W. by N. at Sunset Shortened sail & came to the
wind Nothing of note in sight

Lat. 17-51 S Long 69-57 So ends this day
Monday Feb 23rd

This day opens with a light breeze from the S. Steering
by it on the Western Tack at daylight made all sail & kept
N. by W. found the flying jib stay Standard Tack etc in repaired
and put it up. Made spinnaker in Sunset Shortened sail
& came to the wind on the Western Tack with spinnaker
black Lat. 17-26 S Long 69-43 So ends this day
Tuesday Feb 24th

This day opens with a light breeze from S. Steering
by it on the Western Tack at daylight made all sail &
were around and kept E. by N. at sunrise light saw spinnaker
& ship's Watch employed in Ships Duty
Shortened sail as usual came to the wind on the
Eastern Tack Lat. 16-54 S Long 69-00 So ends
Wednesday Feb 25th
