

Remarks On Board Bark *Bethen* of New Bedford

Thursday Feb 24th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W. at daylight made all sail & kept S. by S. Watch employed in Stairs duty at 11 AM Shortened sail & nothing of note in sight Sp. 15-51 S. So Cards this day

Friday Feb 25th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W. Steaming S. by E. at daylight made all sail Watch employed in cleaning iron work outside of the ship Nothing of note in sight Shortened sail in light sails Steaming S. by E. Sp. 15-21 S. Sp. 15-01 S. So Cards this day

Saturday Feb 26th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W. Steaming S. by E. at 9 o'clock A.M. made all sail at daylight Saw the harbor about 9 A.M. kept off for Little Fish Bay Watch employed cleaning iron work at 4 P.M. all hands employed in getting up the cables & anchors of off the bow at 6 P.M. let go anchors in Little Fish Bay in 4 1/2 fathoms of water with 25 fathoms of cable and in the water fished the Hake. lowered S. Bow Boat Capt. & crew went on shore came back about 9 P.M. took up the load brought of 100 lbs of fresh Beef & 2 Boatmen & 2 men the Watch one Custom House officer on Board

Sunday Feb 27th

This day opens with lying at anchor called all hands at daylight & washed off the deck at 2 o'clock A.M. lowered the Hauls Boat took 14 of the men & officers & 2 Boatmen & 2 crew & 2 storage box on shore for Liberty at 9 o'clock P.M. most of the crew came on Board So Cards this day

Monday Feb 28th

This day opens with lying at anchor at 7 A.M. all hands on Board 3 men & 2 Boatmen went on shore Spearwinds of the Hauls employed in washing outside & painting iron work & sent down the sheets & runners & ties So Cards this day

Tuesday March 1st

This day opens with lying at anchor at 7 A.M. all hands on Board Sent S. Watch on shore Sent Watch employed in painting S. Side & listing ship cleaned the sheets & ties and put up what belonged forward at 9 P.M. part of the crew & one man on Deck from the Bark Alice Kennedy came on Board. 100 lbs Beef & 2 men So Cards this day

Wednesday March 2nd

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands on Board at 7 A.M. Sent S. Watch on shore in Liberty S. Watch employed painting S. Side the second coat & put up the sheets and ties & runners & took the storage box missing out of the Watch came of at 9 P.M. So Cards this day
