

Remarks On Board Bark *Bathia* of New Bedford
Thursday March 3

This day opens with lying at anchor at 7 o'clock all hands
on board employed in painting the Port side clearing
the head chains at sunset & then went on shore came on
board at 9 P.M. Bark *Bumblebee* lying off & on

Friday March 4
230 lbs of Beef & 113 sticks of sweet potatoes came on board.
This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed in
painting the Port side & setting up the head gear & painting
and taking it & tarring the mizen rigging and getting ready for
sea at sunset & then went on shore all hands on
board at 9 P.M. So ends this day

Saturday March 5
This day opens with lying at anchor about daylight the
Boatswain that had the Watch reported the Boat gone
that was put astern called all hands and found that
the Steersman & two of the men foremast were gone saw the
Boat to the Wharf lowered the 5th Bow Boat sent a crew
in reported the Deserters & brought back the Boat rest of
the crew employed in Ships Duty one more man came
on board to go to Deserter from the *Alice Knowles* at
sunset & then went on shore all on board at 9 P.M. So ends

Sunday March 6
This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight called all
hands lowered the sails at 9 A.M. took the anchor and
went to sea steering by the wind on the Port tack
heading N.W. by N. with the anchor & steered away
the cable at sunset took in light sails last & then the
Afternoon Boat. Log 11:22 So ends this day

This day opens with a good breeze from the S.W. steering by
it heading about N.W. at daylight made all sail with
employed in Ships Duty took & one Boatswain sick of duty
sunset took in light sails found one Shawmaw man
Log 15:24 So ends this day

Tuesday March 8th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S.W. steering
by it on the Western tack at daylight made full Watch
employed in various jobs heeled under key of Buttles & a coil
of Gas line nothing in sight of the latter part Wind the
same heading W.S.W. same & then off duty

Log 15:55 S. Log 16:32 So ends this day

Wednesday March 9th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W. steering
by it on the Western tack heading from S.W. to W.S.W. Watch
employed in Ships Duty nothing of note in sight
all hands on duty

Log 15:24 S. No other So ends this day

Thursday March 10th

This day opens with a light breeze from S.E. steering by it
on the Port tack heading S.W. with all sail except fore gallant
sail nothing larger than porpoises in sight Watch employed
in Ships duty sunset took in light sails latter part Wind
S.W. heading W.S.W.
