

Remains on Board Bark Beatha off New Bedford
Monday April 11th

This day opens with a fresh breeze from the S. & lying
off the Island at a distance of 10 miles kept up for the day at
5. On board all hands took the anchors of the Bark and
shackled with the chains and at last in the night
he came off and anchored the vessel about a mile to the
west of the Sails then Miss White went on shore for
twenty four hours. All hands except him employed in ships
Duty took on board from the Schooner Lathie Beath
6 Casks of Bread one Barrel of Beans 3 Barrels of Potatoes
3 pine Boards 2 packages of Paper one Box of Nails
Lighter brought off 2 Boxes of Wood from shore.
Took 140 lbs of Water from the Water Boat
at dark part of the crew went on shore and Beath
Took the Watch anchored in 20 fathoms of Water with
38 fathoms of chain out. So ends this day

Tuesday April 12th

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands on Board at
6 o'clock except one Master & 4 hands took on board one cask
of Coal from Bark Hamlet on Board from shore brought
off 6 Shocks of Sweet Potatoes & some small Store. Men
employed in getting for Sea part of the crew on shore
and Beath discharged the Ship in Beath about
16 minutes ago home was
At 5 o'clock took up the anchor and went to Sea all
on Board except Captain & Miss White made the anchors
Beath and put the Captains below kept by the Watch on
the Western Tack under 12 sails and this morning Sails

Robinson Master off St. Helena
Wednesday April 13th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S. & steering
by it on the Eastern Tack at daylight made all sail from
the Wharves at 10 AM wind freshened according to W. by S.
Sunset Shortened Sail Watch employed in ships duty
Lat. 15. 12 S. So ends this day

Thursday April 14th

This day opens with a fresh breeze from the S. & steering by
it on the Western Tack at 3 AM wind around in daylight
made sail and stood in line sighted the land at 10 AM
at 2 AM wind around three Sails in sight So ends this day

Friday April 15th

This day opens with a fresh breeze from S. & steering by it
heading to the S at 5 o'clock stood in shore sighted the Island
about 10 o'clock at 11 AM Sails in sight at sunset Shortened
Sail & stood off shore Island bearing S. W. by S. So ends

Saturday April 16th

This day opens with a good breeze from S. & steering by it heading
off shore at 9 o'clock the Tack the reefs and of the topsails and
wind around nothing but one sail in sight So ends

Sunday April 17th

This day opens with a light breeze from S. & at 9 o'clock
were around heading in shore at 5 PM the Bark the Island
& Wharves in sight at 5 PM shortened with the
Bark Watch came on Board about 10 o'clock
& stood off shore under Short Sail In land bearing
W. by S. So ends this day
