

Remarks for Board Book Boston of ship Eastport
Saturdays May 24th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight sent
two boats to cruising round the wharves about 9 o'clock
got the ship under weigh & steered N. by W. at 5 P.M. the
anchored in 15 fathoms & 30 of Chain Boats came along
side about dusk saw no Whales

Sundays May 25th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight sent
the Mate & Third Mate back up the anchor about 9 A.M.
and steered along the land N. by W. gave off New Backs
falls for the 4th boat and one for the 3rd boat Boats
came along side about sunset let go anchor at 4 o'clock
in 5 fathoms and 30 fathoms of cable saw no Whales

Thursdays May 26th

This day opens with lying at anchor at 9 A.M. sent Second
& Third Mate cruising about 10 got the vessel under weigh
and steered to the North with light breeze from the South
Boats came along side about dusk saw nothing let
go anchor about 1 o'clock in 5 fathoms & 20 fathoms of chain
saw 10-5-2 S. no Whales so bade this day

Friday May 27th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight two
boats sent to cruising Second Mate took his boat and
Boat and repaired his fishhook and put her out on
the ground about 11 o'clock P.M. had a breeze from the
S. to get under weigh and kept to the Northward
Boats came along side about sunset and let go
anchor in 10 fathoms of water & 20 fathoms of cable

Robinsons Master for the coast of Africa & Humphreys
Saturdays May 28th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight sent two
boats to cruising and got the vessel under weigh and kept
to the Northward along the land anchored about 3 o'clock
in 15 fathoms & 20 fathoms of cable Boats came along side
at sunset saw no Whales so bade this day

Sundays May 29th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight sent
two boats to cruising got the vessel under weigh about
9 o'clock and went across Long River saw no Whales
Boat lowered at Boat and went along side he was
bound to Boston said boats came along side at
9 o'clock saw nothing of note let go anchor about
sunset in 10 fathoms & 20 fathoms of cable

Monday May 30th

This day opens with lying at anchor at 7 o'clock P.M.
took the anchor and made sail & kept along the coast
saw no Boat about 10 P.M. the Capt came along side
it was Capt. Shannan from the Watch Boat told me
bound to Boston said he had been trying to work up
there for 2 months and had made only about 100 miles
he came on board for advice but did not stop but at short
times at 12 o'clock let go anchor in Kabeton Bay in 15
fathoms & 20 of cable took the Boat of the house
& lowered the 3rd Boat and went to see about getting some
wood part of the crew went on shore in the evening
all on board at 9 o'clock except Walter & Dandy
