

Remarks for Board Book of New Bedford
Tuesday June 14th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight and
at 10 o'clock from the South got under weigh and kept
On N. W. till 4 P.M. anchored off Magazine Bay in
19 fathoms of water & 40 fms. from shore. Sent down the
main spence repaired and stowed it away and fore
topmast stay sail. So ends this day.

Wednesday June 15th

This day opens with lying at anchor at 8 o'clock
at 10 o'clock sent a Cruising Capt. & crew went
on shore came back about 1 o'clock other 2 boats
came along side about sunset saw no Whales.

Thursday June 16th

This day opens with lying at anchor at 8 o'clock 2 boats
went a Cruising the rest of the crew employed in
ships duty about sunset the boats came along side
saw no Whales. So ends this day.

Friday June 17th

This day opens with lying at anchor sent 2 boats
a Cruising remainder of the crew employed in
ships duty took the Waite boat & put her on the
tackle for the leakeed boat put the spare boat on the
tackle the other boats came along side about sunset
nothing in sight of whale.

So ends this day

Saturday June 18th

This day opens with lying at anchor sent 2 boats a
Cruising as usual came along side about sunset saw
Whales the Steamer Anderson anchored about 3
hours toward South. So ends this day.

Sunday June 19th

This day opens with lying at anchor about 10 o'clock
at 11 o'clock crew went on shore came back about
dark brought off one whale (a native of Sealander)
to go in the ship. So ends this day.

Monday June 20th

This day opens with lying at anchor 2 boats went
a Cruising about 8 o'clock at 10 o'clock returned about dark
took off 1000 lbs. of seal and one coil of sealing
and the new rigging for the S. boats sail.

Tuesday June 21st

This day opens with lying at anchor at 8 o'clock sent 2
boats a Cruising about 9 o'clock saw Whales from
the ship lowered the other 2 boats and chased
gave them up and came along side about 2 P.M.
went down after more Whales but could not get
on to them the other boats saw Whales twice
chased without success all 4 boats came along side
about sunset. So ends this day.
