Thursday Nov 3

This day begins with squally weather good breeze ship heading N.W. with all sail out middle and latter part light winds this ends

Friday Nov 4

This day begins with clear and fine weather light winds calm. We are employed in ship duty middle part squally latter calm ship heading N.W. this ends

Saturday Nov 5. Lat 9.41.0 Log 41.0

This day begins with good and fine with moderate breeze ship heading N.W. with all sail out. We are employed in various jobs middle and latter part good winds so this ends.

Sunday Nov 6 Lat 10.26 Log 42.10

This day begins with clear and fine weather with moderate breeze middle part much the same latter strong N. West trades and squally this ends

Monday Nov 7

This day begins with squally weather with strong wind ship heading N.W. with all sail out middle and latter strong winds. We are employed in various jobs so this ends

Tuesday Nov 8

Lat 13.30 Log 46.30

This day begins with strong breezes ship heading N.W. the ship went the last 24 one hundred and eighty miles middle and latter part more moderate this ends

Wednesday Nov 9

Lat 15.12 Log 48.80

This day begins with thick cloudy weather wind from the South East ship heading N.W. We are employed in various jobs middle and latter part calm so this ends these 24 hours

Thursday Nov 10

Lat 16.22 Log 50.50

This day begins with calm at first. A breeze sprang up from the N. West ship heading N.W. with all sail out middle and latter part good breeze and squally and

Friday Nov 11

Lat 18.00 Log 51.00

This day begins with thick cloudy weather and squally with strong N. West trades with heavy swell ship heading N.W. making N. West nothing higher than main deck. Sallent with gain the rate of 2 knots per hour middle and latter part the same strong winds so ends this day

Saturday Nov 12

Lat 19.05 Log 54.00

This day begins with clear and fine weather strong N. West trades steering a course. N. West split the fore top Sallent sail sent it down and bent another middle and latter part the same with strong breeze made 20.7 miles the last 24 hours
