Sunday Nov 13 Lat 20.52 Long 57.24

This day begins with strong N East trades clear and fine weather ship heading N West with all sail out middle and latter part strong winds we are employed in scraping stowage on this ends.

Monday Nov 14

This day comes in with clear and fine weather moderate breezes we are employed in various jobs one Steamer in sight heading to the Eastward one schooner heading to S West middle and latter part light winds this ends.

Tuesday Nov 15

This day begins with light winds ship heading N West saw one sail the was heading S. West we are employed in various jobs middle and latter part much the same to this ends.

Wednesday Nov 16

This day begins with strong winds from the N West ship heading N West at sun set took in the main top middle and latter part moderate gail from the West with rain took in sail double reef the top sails part one ship heading to the N.

Thursday Nov 17 Lat 22.00 Long 63.5

This day comes in with moderate gail from the West ship heading N. West running under short sail middle and latter part more moderate wind sail to this ends.

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Friday Nov 18 Lat 20.52 Long 66.20

This day begins with clear and fine weather light moderate breezes from the S. West ship heading N. West with all sail out we are employed in various jobs middle and latter part light winds painting ship this ends.

Saturday Nov 19

Lat 21.40 Long 68.50

This day begins with clear and fine weather light from the S. West posed three sails we are employed painting ship middle and latter part strong winds this ends.

Sunday Nov 20

This day begins with squally and rainy moderate rain from the N. West ship under double reef middle and fore sail of it and sprinker heading West no observation middle more moderate after good fine weather heavy swell this ends.

Monday Nov 21

This day begins with clear and fine weather light breezes from the S. West we run the Longitude out ship heading North with all sail out Barometer falling middle strong winds took in the main reef latter part squally wind came out from the N hauled in to the N. West took in all it took in the main top sail hove to under short sail this ends Barometer rising
