

Remarks on board of Weather of the Bedford
Tuesday Nov 22

This day begins thick cloudy some squally at twelve moderated at whole. Topsails of the ship heading her course at six am the wind hauled to West and sails in sight heading to the North Middle part rainy strong winds latter part nearly a calm. At five pm took in main and fore sail duffle reef the Topsails this ends

Wednesday Nov 23

This day begins thick cloudy weather and rain at three am the wind died out calm became in the Northern edge of the Gulf Stream Longitude and Latitude by dead reckoning 73.40 W Lat 37 00 N Middle part light winds at ten the wind from S. West increased around to N. West strong winds with rain latter part a gale of wind. Barometer down to 29. this ends

Thursday Nov 24

This day begins with thick cloudy and rainy and heavy squalls blowing a gale of wind from the North ship hove to in the Harbor of Tack under goose wing main Top sails blowing heavy barometer rising Middle part the same latter part some moderate made sail cold

This day begins with cloudy and cold weather light winds and calm ship heading to the N. West wind from the North at four am light breeze up from the West ship heading her course N. by West with all sail out middle and latter part light breezes from the S. West

Saturday Nov 26

This day begins with clear and fine weather strong winds heading to the N. by West at one am hauled up to the N. West at four reefed fore and main Top sails plenty of sails in sight one hundred and twenty miles from Montserrat light Middle part light winds at twelve made fire Island light latter part strong breeze at eleven pm made Montserrat light this ends

Sunday Nov 27

This day begins with strong breezes from S. West steering for Block Island took New Port Pilot at 11 William Wilson ~~the~~ Forward ship and hest his anchor come to anchor of Corks point in N. Bedford at nine am all hands furling sails at day light the Trig came to anchor the Towed us to the wharf at nine am for the wharf.
