41 Sunday November 24th 1850

First part of this day fine
fore hours thick overcast weather & moderate
at breezes from the South & East Ship
steering by the wind heading S.W. under
all sail with light squalls of rain. Middle
part pleasant wind from the E by N Ship
steering South. Latter part squally with rain
saw 2 Brigs steering to the Southward

Latitude 4° 0' Observation this Day

42 Monday Nov 25th

First part of this day fine
pleasant weather with light squalls of
rain. A Brig in sight. Ship steering
South wind from the Eastward with
plenty of rain. Saw Blackfish. Middle
part light winds with rain. Latter part
calm with variable winds with heavy
rain. Saw nothing of Note. Employed in duty

No Observation this Day

43 Tues day Nov 26th

First part of this day thick
overcast weather & light variable winds from
N to E with plenty of rain. Saw nothing of
Note caught 3 Dolphins. Middle part light
winds from the Eastward. Ship steering
S.W. under all sail. Latter part the
same. Saw Porpoises & 2 Dolphins & 1 Seal.

Latitude 5.52 N Longitude 21.35

44 Wednesday Nov 27th

First part of this day fine
pleasant weather & moderate winds from
the Eastward. Ship steering South under
all sail. Employed in ship's duty. Middle
part the same. Latter part wind E by N
Ship steering South under all sail. Saw
2 Brigs. Employed in heaving the deck.

Latitude 4.09 N Longitude 21.25 W

Fairhaven Given Fisher Master

45 Thurs day November 28th 1850

First part of this day fine pleasant
weather & moderate breezes from the Eastward
Ship steering by the wind under all sail
heading S.W. Middle part the same
Latter part wind the same. Employed in
Ship's duty. Saw nothing this day hope to
soon if the Lord is willing. Latitude 2.55 N

Longitude 21.35 W

46 Friday Nov 29th 1850

First part of this day fine
pleasant weather & moderate wind from
the E by N. Ship steering by the wind heading
S.W. under all sail. Middle part very
pleasant. Latter part much the same. Employed
in sending down main royal & sent down
a flagstaff & rope ear & saw nothing

Latitude 5 miles N Longitude 28.15 W

47 Satur day Nov 30th

First part of this day fine pleat
ant weather & moderate winds from the E
Ship steering S.W. by the wind. Employed
in taring the rigging & other small jobs & co
Middle part much the same. Latter
part wind S by E Ship steering by the
wind heading S.W. under all sail. Saw
nothing of Note. Employed in taring the rigging

Latitude 5 miles N Longitude 28.15 W

48 Sunday December 1st 1850

First part of this day fine pleat
ant weather & moderate breezes from the E by N
Ship steering by the wind heading S.W. under
all sail. at sun set saw Blackfish
Middle & Latter part very pleasant with
light wind from the E by N Ship steering
by the wind heading S.W. under all sail
& Employed in ship's duty
