80 Thursday January 2^d 1851

First part of this Day thick overcast weather & strong breeze from the Northward Ship steering S.W. under Double reefed Top sail & Main sail at 2 A.M. wind veered to the N.E.W. Ship steering by the wind heading S.S.W. under Top sail Middle part pleasant latter part the same wind from the Westward Ship heading South under Double reef Top sail & courses & Jib saw a Kink back & saw Fish Employed in ship duty Latitude 41.14 South Longitude 52.03 West

81 Friday January 3rd

First part of this Day fine pleasant weather & moderate winds from the E.S.E. Ship steering S.W. under all sail Employed in ship duty saw Nothing of Note till 4 P.M. to 5 P.M. Middle part the same latter part thick squally weather & moderate breeze from the S.E. Ship steering S.W. under Top sail & courses & Jib saw Nothing No Observation this Day

82 Saturday January 4th

First part of this Day fine pleasant weather & moderate breeze from the Southward Ship steering by the wind heading N.W. at 3 A.M. bent a new main Top Gallant sail at 6 A.M. bent a new Fore top sail at 7 A.M. tacked Ship to the Southward wind about West N.W. Middle part strong breeze from the N.W. Curled Top gallant sail & Jib & Main sail latter part at 8 P.M. tacked to the N.W. at 11 P.M. tacked to the S.E. & winds variable with pleasant weather

83 Sunday January 5th

First part of this Day fine pleasant weather & moderate breeze from the N.W. Ship steering by the wind heading S.E. with Top sail courses & Jib & Main sail Middle part much the same latter part pleasant wind from the N.W. Ship steering S.W. under all sail saw a Kink back Latitude 44.56 South Longitude 55.00 West

84 Monday January 6th 1851

First part of this Day fine pleasant weather & light breeze from the N.W. Ship steering S.W. under all sail saw a Kink back Middle part pleasant under same sail latter part the same set all sail & Ship steering S.W. saw Nothing of Note Employed in ship duty

Latitude 45.50 Longitude 56.25 W

85 Tuesday Jan 7th

First part of this Day fine pleasant weather & ray light breeze from the N.W. Ship lying with main Top sail to the mast Middle part much the same with thick fog latter part wind from the N.E.W. Ship steering S.W. under all sail saw a Ship steering S.W. Employed in sending a new mizzen Top sail & Top gallant sail saw a Sulphur Bottom

Latitude 46.30 S Longitude 56.44 W

86 Wednesday Jan 8th

First part of this Day fine pleasant weather & light breeze from the N.W. Ship steering N.W. under all sail a Ship in sight off the weather bow steering S.S.W. Employed in ship duty Middle part ray light breeze latter part Palm ship in sight Employed in repairing the main sail saw Porpoise & Grampet

Latitude 47.05 S Longitude 56.55 W

87 Thursday Jan 9th

First part of this Day fine pleasant weather & light winds from the N.W. Ship steering by the wind heading South under all sail saw Grampet saw one Boat in chase of them but caught none bent the main sail Middle part pleasant with strong breeze from the S.E.W. Ship steering by the wind heading S.E. at 12 M. Hauled all Hands to shorten sail blowing a strong Gale from the S.E.W. Ship lying too under Double reefed Main top sail & Main top gallant stay sail. Latter part more moderate set Double reefed Top sail & Fore sail heading S.E.
