Charles Main sail & top strong breeze & very heavy swell from Eastward

First part of this day thick overcast weather & moderate breeze from the N.W. ship steering by the wind heading S.W. under all sail. Middle part strong gale from the S.W. under all sail but later reefed main top sail & bare top mast stay sail. Blowing very heavy from S.W.
