

Remarks on Board Ship W^m West of

305 Friday August 15th 1851

First part of the day very heavy Gale from the S.W. at 1 P.M. took in the Bow Boat Ship lying too under Mast reefed Main Top sail & fore top mast stay sail. Latter part more moderate wind from the Southward Ship steering by South under all sail. Saw Nothing of Note
No Observation this day

306 Saturday August 16th

First part of the day thick overcast weather & moderate from the Southward Ship steering by South under all sail. Middle part pleasant Latter part thick with moderate breeze from the S.E. Ship steering by the wind heading East under all sail
Latitude 42° 32' North

307 Sunday August 17th

First part of the day thick overcast weather & moderate breeze from the S.E. Ship steering by the wind heading to the Eastward under all sail. Middle part strong breeze from Southward Ship steering by S under variable breeze Top sail fore sail & reefed Main sail Latter part squally wind the same at 10 o'clock sent down the Main Top sail & bent a new one.
No Observation this day

308 Monday August 18th

First part of the day thick squally weather & moderate strong breeze from the Southward Ship steering by S under T.K. Top sail & courses. Capt. Fisher sick. Middle part much the same Latter part wind from the N.W. Ship steering by S under all sail. thick squally weather & moderate breeze. Employed in ship duty. Looked over the deck &c.

309 Tuesday August 19th

First part of the day thick overcast weather & moderate breeze from the N.W. Ship steering by S under T.K. Top sail courses & f.b. Middle part more moderate set all sail. Latter part very light breeze from the N.E. Ship steering by S.E. under all sail saw plenty of porpoise & a few sculpin Jack.

310 Wednesday August 20th 1851

First part of the day thick overcast weather & very light breeze from the N.E. Ship steering by the wind heading S.E. under all sail. Middle part very light breeze & Latter part moderate breeze from the S.E. Ship under all sail steering by the wind heading by S this is the first pleasant day we have had for over 1 month

311 Thursday August 21st

First part of the day fine pleasant weather & moderate breeze from the S.E. Ship steering by the wind heading East under all sail. Middle part much the same Latter part very pleasant Ship under all sail. Saw plenty porpoise & pumpkins. Employed in ship duty

Longitude 169° 12' West

312 Friday August 22nd

First part of the day fine pleasant weather & moderate breeze from the S.E. Ship steering by the wind heading by South under all sail. Middle part the same Latter part wind S.E. at 10 o'clock reefed ship to the Southward very pleasant Employed in ship duty
Latitude 39° 11' North
Longitude 168° 05' West

313 Saturday August 23rd

First part of the day fine pleasant weather & moderate breeze from the S.E. Ship steering by the wind heading S.E. under all sail. Middle part very pleasant Latter part much the same wind from the Eastward Ship steering by the wind heading to the S.E. under all sail. Saw many pumpkins & porpoise &c.

314 Sunday August 24th

First part of the day fine pleasant weather & moderate breeze from the Eastward Ship steering by the wind heading S.E. under all sail saw plenty porpoise. Middle part pleasant Latter part much the same wind from the Eastward Ship steering by the wind heading S.E. under all sail.
