This day comes in with thick fog wind from the S.E. back in the light sail blowing fresh at 3 P.M. cleared up some saw 2 whales at 5 it came in thick a gain middle part the same latter part lit up some saw a little while saw a few gras came in thick a gain halled the main yard to back and let her lay untill better weather so ends this day

669 Remarks On Board Sunday August ^{the} 15th 1852

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the S.W. heading to the S.W. with thick fog at 6 P.M. lit up some saw 2 ships one a whaling and one a cutting. The ship a gain and cleared to the west saw a plenty of ships but no whales were ship a gain spoke the barque Harvest of fairweather Captain Caird on board so ends

670 Remarks On Board Monday August ^{the} 16th 1852

This day comes in with a light breeze from the South steering to East thick fog middle part the same clear fresh double reef the top sails latter part the same sail saw nothing but ships and a plenty of them some whaling some cutting so ends

On The West Coast of Kuchia in the year 1852

671 Remarks On Board Tuesday August ^{the} 17th 1852

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the North heading on the wind to the East carrying double reef top sails saw some grain and ships middle part the same latter part saw a plenty of whales but very rigid, lored and chased but got nothing and parted hove to the West and breasted on so ends this

672 Remarks On Board Wednesday August ^{the} 18th 1852

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the N.W. heading N.E. carrying double reef top sails saw a number of whales lored and chased but got nothing at 5 P.M. more ship to the west thick and rainy middle part the same latter part more ships back in the fore top sail saw nothing but ships so ends this day

673 Remarks On Board Thursday August ^{the} 19th 1852

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the N.W. heading N.E. carrying the foresail and double reef main and mizen saw 3 ships and one whale middle part equally latter part the same set double reef fore top sail saw 2 whales but to rugged to have caloponia grain so ends this day
