She sailed at 6 A.M. commenced stowing down in the fore hold coiled down the masts thick fog and rain. Saw nothing but ships so ends this day.

681 Remarks On Board Friday August ^{the} 27 1852

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the N.E. a tender with fog and rain saw nothing. Got employed in stowing down at 8 P.M. got through. Started the masts were ships to the East at 6 P.M. Heard up some fine weather middle part thick and fog & latter part the same saw nothing ships. Employed in byling so ends this day.

682 Remarks On Board Saturday August ^{the} 28 1852

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the North heading to the West saw some grain. More masts middle and latter part the same. Saw nothing but ships employed in byling so ends this day.

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the North heading to the East saw a plenty of grain. But no masts middle part got through byling. Latter part employed in shaking out water by the ship's yard of Edgerton most feel so ends this day with fog and rain.

684 Remarks On Board Monday August ^{the} 30 1852

This day comes in with a light breeze from the North heading from the West to the East saw nothing. But grain at 7 P.M. set the fore and main top sail fog hit up some middle part the same in the morning commenced stowing down fine weather. Saw 12 ships some a byling some a cutting so ends this day.

This day comes in with a fine breeze from the N.W. steering to the East saw a plenty of grain at 3 P.M. got through stowing down made all sail steering East middle part calm latter part a light breeze from the N.E. saw a school and a plenty of grain so ends this day.
