706 Remarks on Board Wednesday Sept 22 1852

This day comes in with a light breeze from the NNE heading E carrying all sail middle calm latter part of fine breeze from the west clearing to East but top must stand by sail and one ship boards

707 Remarks on Board Thursday Sept 23

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the West clearing East carrying all sail in company with a rather ship middle part and latter part the rain took in the miser top sail and top must stand by sail some squally so ends this day

Lat by obs 45-50 N
Long by chro 177-02 W

708 Remark on Board Friday Sept 24 1852

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the west clearing East some squally at 5 P.M. have had to let the standing sail and let her E by N. and a ship standing the rain way middle part the rain latter wind came to the South came in thick and rainy carrying all sail so ends this day

Long the same

703 Remarks on Board Sunday Sept 19 1852

First part of these 24 hours comes in with a fine breeze from the ESE heading on the wind SE by E carrying all sail in company with a rather ship middle part and latter part the rain saw nothing more so ends this day till night

Lat by obs 49-28 N
Long none this day

704 Remarks on Board Monday Sept 20

This day comes in with a strong breeze from the E clearing on the wind heading SSE middle part squally double reefed the top sails in the morning made all sail more sudret at 10 A.M. wind came to the SE tacked ship to the NNE and one sail standing the rain way so ends

Long by chro 173-14 E

705 Remarks on Board Tuesday Sept 21 1852

This day comes in with a light breeze from the ESE steering to the NNE at 6 P.M. more ship so the SE wind came more to the North middle part and latter part the rain saw nothing so ends this day employed in ship's duty
