manned by three natives

801 Remarks Friday December 31st 1852
This day comes with fine pleasant
weather from S. East the ship
off and on Parities at 1 P.M.
the Capt. left the ship
and went on shore at 6 P.M.
returned

finished hauling

802 Remarks Saturday January 1st 1853
This day commences with light
air and pleasant from S. East
the ship by the wind on the larboard
tack Middle and latter part the
same at 10 A.M. saw a ship

803 Remarks Sunday January 2nd 1853
This day commences with light air
and pleasant from S. West steering
S.S. East and sail in site
Middle and latter part wind
from S. East the ship by the wind
on the larboard tack

Obs Lat 25.05 South Long 148.36 West

804 Remarks Monday January 3rd 1853
First part of this day comes
with light air and calm from
S. East the ship by the wind
on the larboard tack by the wind
Spoke ship Olympia Middle and latter part brisk
breezes attended with frequent
squalls rain from South

Obs Lat 26.13 South Long West

805 Remarks Tuesday January 4th 1853
This day commences with
brisk breezes attended with
frequent squalls of rain from
South the ship by the wind
on the larboard tack Middle
strong gales from South at 8 P.M.
tacked ship to the eastward latter
part fresh gales and pleasant
from S.S. East at 8 P.M. saw
ship to the S. West took in all
sail and commenced stowing
it. Obs Lat 26.42 South Long 149.24 West
