 land bearing W. N. W. 40 miles distant

 part steered North
 Obs Lat 7.22 South Long 35.59 W

911 Remarks Wednesday April 20th 1853
 This day commences with
 brisk breezes and pleasant from
 S. E. by East steering North Middle and
 latter part the same
 Obs Lat 5.30 South Long 36.36 W

912 Remarks Thursday April 21st 1853
 This day commences with strong
 winds and passing clouds
 steering North Middle and
 latter part much the same

913 Remarks Friday April 22nd 1853
 This day commences with
 brisk S. E. by East winds and
 pleasant steering North
 Middle and latter part much the
 same
