This day comes with brisk breezes and pleasant from Eastward Steering N. by W. with Middle and latter part light air and pleasant four sails in sight.

939 Remarks Wednesday May 18th 1853

This day comes with light air and pleasant Steering North wind from S. East four sails in sight Middle and latter part brisk breezes and pleasant

Obs Lat 36.08 North Long 69.56 West

940 Remarks Thursday May 19th 1853

This day commences with brisk breezes and pleasant from South Steering N. by West Middle part the same latter part strong winds from S. West and foggy

Obs Lat 38.13 North Long 70.35 West

Remarks Friday May 20th 1853

This day comes with strong winds from S. West Steering N. by North saw a number of sails Steering S. East at 8 P.M. the wind shifted suddenly to the N. West hauled top & sail. and double reefed the topsails the ship by the way the latter part strong winds and pleasant set the topsails saw a number of sail Steering various ways

Obs Lat 40.00 North Long 71.12 West

Remarks Saturday May 21st 1853

This day comes with strong winds and pleasant from Westward Steering N. by West with all mizzen sail set a number of sails in sight at 8 P.M. saw Mount Point at 10 P.M. sounded found 32 fathoms grey sand kept of Steered N. by East at 2 P.M. took a Pilot set all and started for the bar at 10 A.M. anchored off Clark's point, hauled the sails and all hands went ashore

Remarks Sunday May 22nd 1853

This day commences with strong winds and pleasant from Southward the ship at anchor
