

Ship "Wm. West of New Bedford E. R.

Monday Oct. 29 A.D. 1855

First part fine breeze from E.S.E. steering to the land for the passage all sail out muddles part here to under short sail. Latter part at 6 A.M. keep off for the passage at 10 A.M. in the passage with light variable air at 1 P.M. got a light breeze worked into the harbor at 3 P.M. came to anchor in 10 fathoms water 33 sail in port no merchant ships So Ends Sea Account

Tuesday Oct. 30th

All this day light air and pleasant with very warm weather all hands employ in washing ships Thus Ends this day

Wednesday Oct. 31st

This day light air and overcast weather all hands employ in breaking out Provision &c. got off a raft of water Several ships sailed So Ends this day

Thursday Nov. 1st

Light breeze and pleasant weather employ in getting off a raft of water and painting the Lar. side of the ship So Ends this day

Friday Nov. 2nd

This day a light breeze and fine weather all hands employ in painting &c. So Ends this day

Saturday Nov. 3rd

This day light air and pleasant all hands on board employ in painting Stowing water and landing a raft on shore Thus ends this day

Sunday Nov. 4th

All this day light wind and pleasant weather the Star. watch on shore at dusk all hands on board Thus Ends this day 3 ships arrived

Monday Nov. 5th

This day pleasant weather a light breeze the Lar. watch on shore those on board employ in painting at 7 P.M. all hands on board except the officers

Tuesday Nov. 6th A.D. 1855

This day light air and pleasant weather the Star. Watch on shore those on board employ in painting &c. discharged the 4 natives and the 2 boat steers Orase J. Wilson and Sylvester Littlefield Several ships arrived So Ends this day

Wednesday Nov. 7th

This day light air and pleasant fine weather the Lar. watch on shore those on board employ painting the Spar and getting off a raft of water 40 Bbls of Potatoes from the Schooner "Whitwick" James G. Harris came on board to go as Steward with us

Thursday Nov. 8th

Fine breeze and pleasant all hands employ in getting off a raft of water and &c. got 4 pigs from the shore So Ends this day

Friday Nov. 9th

Pleasant weather and some wind the Star. watch on shore those on board employ in painting &c. at 8 P.M. all hands on board with 4 exceptions the ship "Saraboga" sailed So Ends this day

Saturday Nov. 10th

Light air and pleasant weather the Lar. Watch on shore several ships arrived and the ship "Eagle" sailed for New Bedford full at dark all hands on

Sunday Nov. 11th

Fine weather and a breeze from sea the Star. watch on shore at 7 P.M. all hands on board Thus Ends this day

Monday Nov. 12th

This day pleasant and a light breeze the Lar. watch on shore those on board employ in ships duties So Ends this day

Tuesday Nov. 13th

Pleasant weather and light air all hands employ in stowing water &c. So Ends this day

Wednesday Nov. 14th

Fine weather and light breeze all hands on board getting ready for sea So Ends this day
