Saturday Nov 17th

This day light breeze from
S.E. wind at 10 A.M. took the anchor and got under way
at 12 Meridian the Capt. came on board. Made sail
and stood out So Ends Civil Act.

Sunday Nov 18th

First part strong trade
from N.E. and pleasant weather the ship under way and
at 5 P.M. off the W. end of Kanai bound seaward all sail
out middle part light breeze latter part light breeze and a
heavy swell under the lee off the land. Saw nothing at all.
So Ends this day

Monday Nov 19th

All this day strong trade from
N.E. and pleasant weather Steering S.E. by E. the light sails in
saw nothing So Ends 19th Lat. by Obs. 17° 10' N
Long. by Chron. 157° 57' W

Tuesday Nov 20th

This day strong wind from N.E.
and pleasant weather Steering S.E. by E. under 1/2 top sails
saw nothing So Ends this day Lat. by Obs. 15° 14' N
Long. by Chron. 157° 25' W

Wednesday Nov 21st

All this day a strong wind
and squally weather Steering S.E. by E. under 1/2 top sails saw
nothing So Ends this day Lat. by Obs. 13° 20' N
Long. by Chron. 156° 54' W

Thursday Nov 22nd

Strong wind from N.E. by E. and
thick squally weather ship under 1/2 top sails Steering S.E. by E.
saw nothing So Ends this day Lat. by Obs. 11° 05' N
Long. by Chron. 155° 27' W

So Ends this day No Obs.

Saturday Nov. 24th

Strong N.E. trades with
rainy squally weather Steering S.E. by E. under
whole top sails So Ends this day Lat. by Obs. 07° 15' N
Long. by Chron. 154° 21' W

Sunday Nov. 25th

First part fresh wind from
N.E. and squally Steering S.E. by E. middle and latter
part light wind rainy Caught a porpoise So Ends No
Lat. by Obs. 1

Monday Nov. 26th

This day light fresh wind
from E.N.E. and pleasant weather Steering S.E. by E.
saw nothing the watch employ in ship duties
So Ends this day No Obs.

Tuesday Nov. 27th

All this day light breeze
from S.E. by E. and pleasant weather Steering by the wind
at 2 P.M. raised the ship's anchor at 7 A.M. took the
ship Abigail of N.H. So Ends 27th Lat. by Obs. 03° 10' N
Long. by Chron. 154° 25' W

Wednesday Nov. 28th

This day light wind from
E.S.E. and pleasant weather Steering S.E. by E. all sail out gamed
with the ship Abigail saw the ship Yamharoo to seaward
Lat. by Obs. 1° 58' N
Long. by Chron. 154° 45' W

Thursday Nov. 29th

Fine weather and light breeze
from E. ward Steering S.E. the watch employ in ship duties
gamed with the ship Yamharoo and Abigail So Ends 29th
Lat. by Obs. 00° 38' N
Long. by Chron. 153° 19' W

Friday Nov. 30th

This day fine breeze and pleasant
weather Steering S.E. by E. all sail out at 8 A.M. gamed with
the ship Yamharoo and Abigail So Ends 30th Lat. by Obs. 24' N
Long. by Chron. 153° 44' W
