This day light breeze from N. E. & pleasant weather the ship on both tacks saw a Barque to leeward at 7 A.M. took the boom up & commenced bundling it at 12 noon spoke the Bark Prince Charles 42 days from London for Swan River So Ends & P. P.

Sunday Mar. 30

All this day fine breeze from N. E. & pleasant weather steering by the wind on both tacks at 5 P.M. finished bundling the Bone 98 bunches in 20 hours work we have bundled 149 Bundles of Bone which turns out at New Bedford. So Ends & P.
at 10 A.M. spoke Bark Merimac of N. London Lat. by Obs. 25. 45
94 days from Honolulu with freight. So Ends this day

First part light & fresh breeze heading N. N. W. in company with the Merimac Middlesex & latter part fresh N. E. wind & pleasant weather heading N. N. W. by the wind all sail out. So Ends & P.

Tuesday April 1st A.D. 1856

All this day fine breeze from N. E. & pleasant steering by the wind at 1 P.M. spoke the Bark Prince Charles of London 42 days out for Swan River at 7 A.M. spoke Bark Oriented of Boston 40 days out for Sydney direct. Nye Master. So Ends this day

Wednesday April 2nd

Light wind from E. N. E. & pleasant steering N. E. by the wind then nothing. Sent another main & fore topsail & foresail to E. N. E. So Ends & P.

Long. by Chron. 30. 20 W.

Thursday April 3rd

Light breeze from E. and some squally steering N. E. all sail out saw nothing. So Ends this day
Lat. by Obs. 19. 12 S.
Long. by Chron. 30. 28 W.

Friday April 4th

Fresh breeze from E. and some squally weather steering N. E. all sail. So Ends & P.
Lat. by Obs. 17. 10 S.
Long. by Chron. 30. 27 W.

Sunday April 5th

This day fresh breeze from the E. and pleasant steering E. by N. late possible sail out. Employ in ship's duties. So Ends this day
Lat. by Obs. 14. 40 S.
Long. by Chron. 30. 28 W.

Sunday April 6th

Fine breeze at E. and pleasant steering N. E. & E. all sail but employing in ship's duties. So Ends & P.
Lat. by Obs. 11. 20 S.
