Left by Oct. 2. 31 A.

Tuesday April 14th

from N. E. & pleasant steering N. N. W. at dusk the Bark was 4 or a mile from us at 6 A. M. she was 4 miles to S. W. of us at 10 & A. M. the main top gallant bark stay painter took in the sail put up a preventer at 12. Mer set it again. So Ends
Lat. 4° 27' North
Long. 41° 50' W.

Wednesday April 15th.

Grades & pleasant weather Steering N.W. by N. All sail out except
the royal The Bark in our wake 2 or 3 miles off the water
employ in Ships duties Distance run 187 Miles S.W. by E. S.
So Ends this day Lat. 4° Ob. 7-12 North
Long. 4 Chrs 43-40 West

Thursday April 16th

This day strong trades from N.E. & pleasant Steering N.W. & N. all sail except the royals out the water employ in Ships duties Dist run 181 Miles N.W. & W. at 13 Mer we lost sight of our neighbour the Finances who went out of sight to the S.E. by E of us
