

Remarks On Board the Ship *Wilmington*

Wednesday December 22^d (1841)

Commences with fresh Gales from the Northward Middle & Latter parts much the same at 7 AM got under weigh in Company with the Ship Swift Bound to the Pacific Ocean at 12 O'clock the Pilot left as we stood out to sea

Thursday December 23^d

Commences with fresh Gales from the N N E hauling gradually to the North at 2 PM Gay Head Bore E N E Dist 20 Miles Latter part fresh Breezes from the Eastward Steering by the wind S E at 8 AM took in the Main topgallant Sail

Friday December 24th Lat by Obs 38 49 N

Commences with fresh Gales from the S E Steering by the wind heading N N W at 2 PM Doubles Recept the Topsail 7 at 4 took in the Sails & Main sail at 4 PM more ship & headed to the Eastward at 7 PM the wind hauled suddenly to the N W attended with rain 11 AM Steer in S E

Saturday December 25th

Commences with fresh Breezes from the N W Steering S E Latter part pleasant Gales at 5 PM Made all Sail Steering S E by E the Watch Employed fitting the Boat

Lat by Obs 36 30 N
Long by Chron 69 30 W

Sunday December 26th

Commences with Moderate Breezes from the N W Steering S E by E Latter part Strong Gales from the N N E Steering E by S at 2 PM took in the Light Sails 7 at 4 Doubles Recept the topsails Latter part fresh Gales & thick Weather

Lat by Obs 35 38 N

Monday December 27th

Commences with fresh Gales from the Westward Steering S E Middle part much the same Latter part fresh Gales from the W N W at 11 AM took in the Fore & Mizzen topsails & Doubles Recept the Main Lat by Obs

December 28th Commences with pleasant Gales from the N N E Steering by the wind to the Eastward at 3 PM made all Sail Latter part light Breezes & Calm the Watch Employed fitting the Boats &c No Ob this Day

Wednesday December 29th

Commences with light Breezes from the S E Steering by the wind heading E N E Latter part pleasant Gales from the S S W Steering E by S at 10 PM shaped a full Rigid Brig Steer in W N W Lat by Obs 35 15 N
Long by Chron 69 00 W

Thursday December 30th

Commences with pleasant Gales from the S W Steering E N E Middle part Strong Breezes from the Westward at 2 PM the wind hauled suddenly to the North attended with rain in the latter light Breezes at 11 AM them again suddenly to the S Lat by Obs 35 00 N

Friday December 31st

Commences with Moderate Breezes & Cloudy middle part light Breezes & Calm Latter part pleasant Breezes from the S W Steering E by S Lat by Obs 34 50 N
Long by Chron 55 40 W

Saturday January 1st

Commences with fresh Gales from the Westward Steering S E Latter part Strong Gales from the W N W at 11 AM took in the Fore & Mizzen topsails & Doubles Recept the Main
