Wednesday February 9th

Commences with Moderate Breezes from the S E Steering S by W Middle & Latter parts variable Winds attended with rain one Sail in Sight

Long 29. 34 W

Thursday February 10th

Commences with with pleasant Fairies from the S E Steering by the wind heading South Middle & Latter parts Squally & variable Weather at 5 PM Made the Island of Trinidad bearing S E Dist 25 Miles 2 Sails in Sight

Friday 11th

Commences with Moderate Breezes from the S E Steering S by W Middle part fresh Breezes & Squally Latter part more moderate at 1 PM Saw 3 small Whales. Lard all 4 Boats started 5 of them & the Corn Drove went on perquid of the others at 11 gave up the chase & came on board

Saturday February 12th

Commences with Moderate Breezes from the S E at 1 PM Lard the Boats for the same Whales that we Lard for in the morning Boat 10 nonpareil at 3 came on board at 5 Lard again Boat 1 without success came on board & took in Sail & Sled & Hatches through the Night Latter parts fresh Breezes & fine Weather at Daylight made 1000 Sail & kept the Ship off S by E

Commences with Moderate Breezes from the Eastward Steering S by W Middle & Latter parts light Breeze & fine Weather

Commences with Moderate Breezes from the Eastward & fine Weather Steering S by W Middle part light Breeze & variable Latter part S Moderate Breeze from the N W at 6 PM Lard the Mainsail & Repear it

Tuesday February 15th

Commences with Moderate Breezes from the N W Steering S by W at 4 PM Bent the Mainsail Middle part fresh Breezes & Cloudy lightning Sharp in the S W Latter part fresh Breeze Squally attended with rain at 8 PM took in the light Sails at 7 PM passed the large Ship Steering N E We Obs this Day

Wednesday February 16th

Commences with fresh Breezes from the N W at 2 PM the wind hauled suddenly to the S E took in the topsails & sails Ship heading S by W Middle & Latter parts fresh Breezes with passing Clouds

Thursday 17th

Commences with fresh Breezes from the S E Steering by the wind heading S by W at 1 PM Double Breezt the topsails Latter part Jibboom & sails from the Eastward at Daylight made 1000 Sail

Friday February 18th

Commences with fresh Breezes from the S E N W with passing Clouds Steering S by W with 1000 Driven Sail out Middle & Latter parts much the same
