Stowing down Latter part Strong Breezes
from the N^W & W Steering by the wind to the
South at Daylight made Ob. Sail 1 Barque
on Sight Steering to the South
Lat by Obs 45.30 S

Sunday March 13th
Commences with fresh Breezes from the N^W
Steering by the wind heading S S E Middle
& Latter parts fresh Gales & Squally at 4 PM
Exchange Signals with Ob. Dutch Barque
& at 5 Double Receipt the topsails at 7 took
in the Eib & Mainsail

Long by Chron 58.00 W

Monday March 14th
Commences with fresh Gales from the N^W
Steering by the wind heading N^W & W
Middle & Latter parts Pleasant Gales

Commences with Moderate Breezes from
the N^W & W Steering S S E at 4 PM
Made the Staten Land Bearing per
Compass S S E at 5 PM the wind
howled suddenly to the South Double receipt
the topsails Middle part variable
Weather Latter part Pleasant Breezes
from the N^W at 4 PM made Ob. Sail
& kept the ship off S S E at 12 Meridian
the East End of Staten Land bore
West 12 3 Leagues
Lat by Obs 54.40

Saturday March 20th
Commences with Moderate Breezes from
N^W at 2 PM the wind howled suddenly
to the S S W Steering by the wind to the
S S under Double Receipt topsails Middle
part variable Weather Latter part
fresh Gales from the N^W Steering
S^W by S with Ob. Drawing Sails
out at 12 Meridian the West End
of Staten Land bore N^W 12
10 Leagues
