Meridian Cape Horn bore West at 10 PM 10 Leagues
No Obs this day

Tuesday March 22

Commences with pleasant gales from the
NW steering by the wind heading
W by S at 1 PM hook on the topgallant sails
a sail or eight steering to the Westward
at 6 PM the Island of Diego Ramirez
bearing SW Middle part calm latter
part moderate breezes from NNE steering
W by S at 12 Meridian the boat part of
Lago bore S by E 3 Leagues

Wednesday March 23

Commences with pleasant gales from the
NW steering by the wind heading SW
Middle & latter parts fresh gales &
thick weather at 7 PM Receipt the
top sails No Obs this day

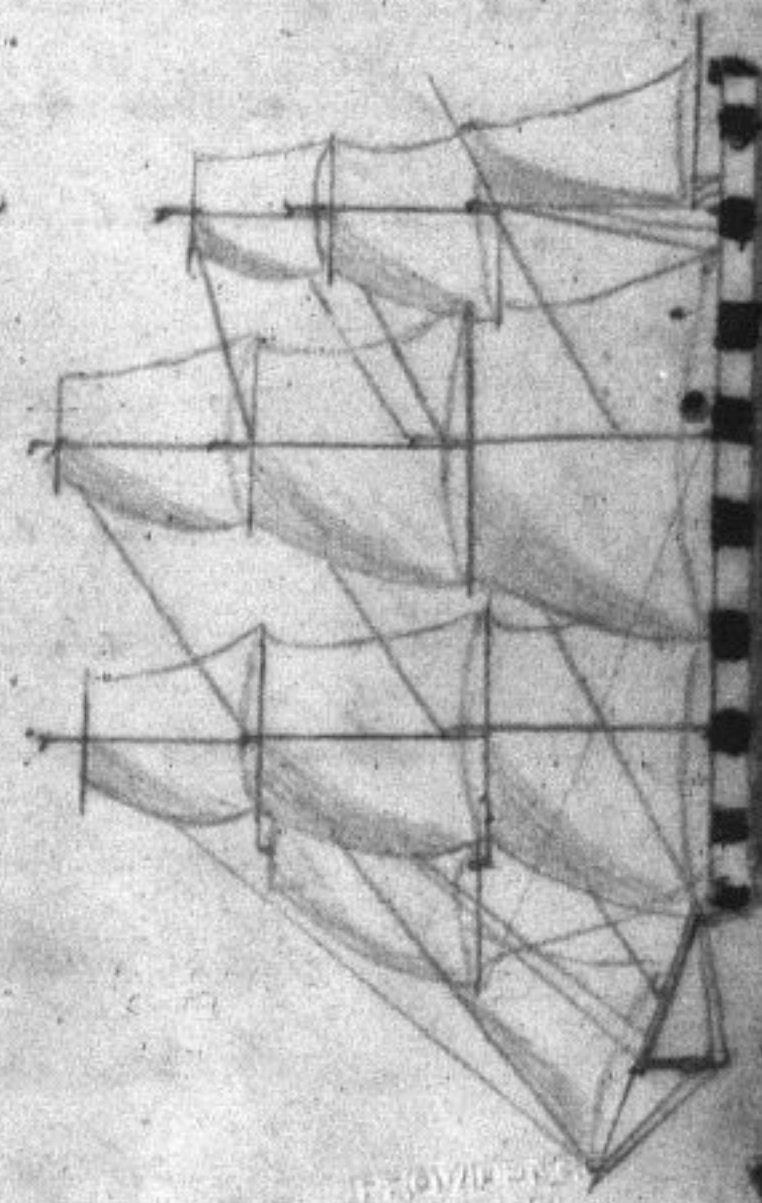
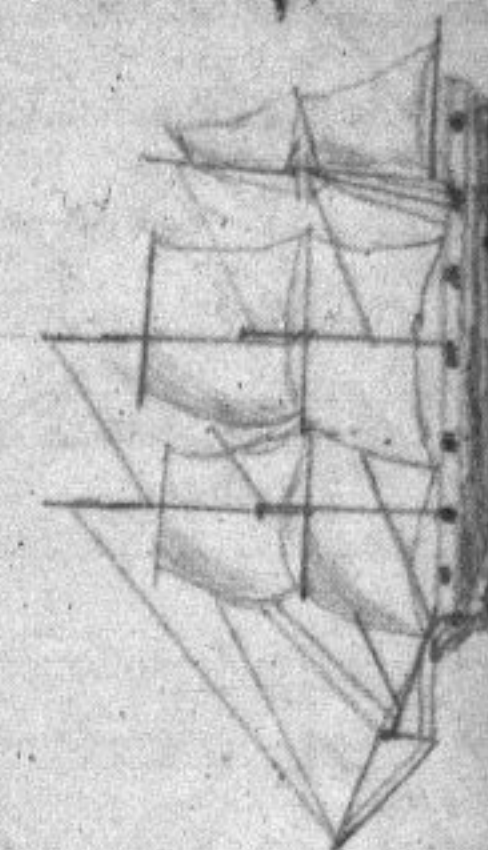
Thursday March 24
