

Ship Wilmington & Liverpool Packet

Thursday Oct 6th

All these 24 hours pleasant weather. Steering by the wind
bearing E by N at 8 AM. Saw 1000
Whales. Board the boat and at a meridian
struck and killed one of them found
an English horn and 30 fat horns of
Cisne attached to him

Lat 40° 30' N

Friday Oct 7th

Came on with pleasant breezes from the
Northward and fine weather at 9 AM
took the whale alongside and cut him in
latter part fine weather. Employed boiling
hops. Clouds in sight off the weather began

Lat 40° 52' N

Saturday Oct 8th

Throughout this 24 hours fine pleasant
weather. Steering by the wind in search of
Whales saw nothing remarkable

Lat 40° 30' N

Sunday Oct 9th

All of these 24 hours moderate breezes from the
Eastward and fine weather. Steering various
courses at 11 AM. Saw patches of land bearing
N by E 5 leagues distant

Lat 40° 40' N
Longitude 176° 40' E

Monday Oct 10th

All of these 24 hours fine clear weather
steering by the wind in search of Whales

Lat 40° 43' N

Tuesday Oct 11th

Throughout this 24 hours fine weather. Steering
by the wind at 9 AM. Spoke the ship
Hesper of Fairhaven 15 Mon this out with
500 bls of Spearm Oil

Lat 40° 05' N
Longitude 176° 23' E

Cruising on the Line Oct 1842

Wednesday Oct 12th

All of these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather. Steering by the wind

Lat 40° 30' N

Thursday Oct 13th

All of these 24 hours fine weather at 4 PM
spoke the ship and Capt. Handey came
on board and spent the evening

Lat 40° 32' N

Friday Oct 14th

Throughout this 24 hours pleasant whole
Quil breezes. Steering by the wind. Employed
blowing down oil

Lat 40° 32' N

Saturday Oct 15th

All of this 24 hours fine weather. Steering by
the wind in search of Whales

Lat 40° 30' N

Sunday Oct 16th

All of this 24 hours fine pleasant weather
steering by the wind at 8 AM. Saw 1000
Whales. Board the boat went on to them
several times but did not fatten. Clarified
Island in sight bearing N by E 3 leagues

Lat 40° 30' N

Monday Oct 17th

Throughout this 24 hours light air and fine
weather at 11 AM. Spoke for the same
Whales that we chased in the forenoon.
Struck and killed one and at 4 PM took him
along side and cut him in. This afternoon
several canoes came off from the
Island with coconuts, yams, &c.
