Came in with fine pleasant weather Steering
by the wind to the S E Employed Coopering
Meat Middle part Squally at 1 PM
took in the top gallant sails Latter part
fresh Gale and Clear at 11 PM Starboard
Whale and kept the Ship for them

Friday Oct 28th

Throughout this 24 hours fresh Breeze
and fair weather at 1 PM Lay off for
the Whales that we raised in the forenoon
got one of them and struck rather the
Starboard Boat lost it time at 4 PM
took the Whale along side and cut her in
