and clear steering N by E under single
sheet topsails. Ample sail mending
done. Ends the year 1842

Sunday January 1st 1843
Come in with strong gales and fine
weather steering N by E latter part fine
at 7 AM made all sail

Lat by Oh 21.22.00
Longitude 144.30 E

Monday January 2nd
Throughout this 24 hours fine pleasant weather
steering N by E with all sail set to the breeze
Lat by Oh 23.23.00

Tuesday January 3rd
Come in with fine weather wind E by S
middle and latter part fresh gales and
clear weather at 7 AM double sheet
the topsails and at 9 AM took in the
mainsail ship heading N by E

Wednesday January 4th
Come in with fresh gales and clear at 4 AM
sent the new fore topsail latter part
fresh gales attended with rain
Lat by Oh

Thursday January 5th
Come in with strong disagreeable weather
steering N by E at 3 PM on board the old
sails and sent the new ones at 5 AM
took in the fore & main topsails and close
sheet the main and stood back crew
watched latter part fresh gales and clear
at 7 AM set double sheet topsails
and kept the ship off at 4 AM wind S by E

Friday January 6th
Come in with fresh gales from the S by E
and clear steering N by E at 6 AM Luff
to under the close sheet main topsail
middle part rainy disagreeable weather
at midnight the wind hauled suddenly
to the N by E latter part fresh gales and
clear ship heading N by E

Lat by Oh 28.57.00
Long by Chron 143.00 E

Saturday January 7th
Begin with fresh gales from the N by E
at 2 AM wore ship and headed to the S by E
middle part more moderate latter part
fine at daylight made all sail
Lat by Oh 28.55.00

Sunday January 8th
first part fine breeze from the westward
steering to the wind in search of whales
at sundown put in double sheet
latter part fresh gales and squally
Lat by Oh 28.20.00

Monday January 9th
Throughout this 24 hours fresh gales and
squally steering to the wind under double
sheet topsails
Lat by Oh 28.20.00

Tuesday January 10th
Come in with fresh gales from N by E
latter part pleasant breeze from the N by E
at daylight made all sail
Lat by Oh 28.20.00
Long by Chron 142.18 E

Wednesday January 11th
Come in with fine weather at sundown took
in all sail put the fore sail and double sheet
main topsail latter part fresh gales from
the westward and squally at 8 AM took
on the fore sail and close sheet the main
topsail
