

Ship Wilmington and Liverpool Packet
Monday Oct 2nd '43

Commenced with calm and pleasant weather at 4 P.M. a breeze sprung up from N.E. Tacked ship at 5 P.M. After part much the same.

Long by Chs 158.01 W.

Tuesday Oct 3rd '43

Commenced with Moderate breezes from N.E. steering on the wind to the Southward and eastward After part much the same.

Lat by Obs 29.33 North
Long by Chs 158.35 West

Wednesday Oct 4th 1843

All these 24 light winds from E.N.E. steering on the wind to the Southward and Eastward. Last evening at about 10 P.M. Jacob Saunders departed this life. He was a native of Wilmington N.C. We took him on board at the Bonny Island with the Bad Disorder, in hopes of giving him some relief but he got worse instead of better until last night when he died. at 7 this morning we all assembled together around the Body when Capt Place read the Funeral services over him and we consign'd him to his watery Grave.

Thursday Oct 5th 1843

Commenced with light winds from East at 1 P.M. raised a sail 1/2 point on our Weather Bearer Tacked ship at 2 P.M. After part Moderate winds from S. steering on the wind to the Eastward.

Long by Chs 156.56 West

Friday Oct 6th 1843

Begins with Moderate breezes from S. steering on the wind. Painting Star Board. Sailed on our Weather Quarter. All Well. Thank God. After part. Strong breezes from S. by East.

Lat by Obs 28.00 N.
Long by Chs 154.50 W.

Sat Saturday Oct 7th 1843

Commenced with strong breezes from S. by E. steering on the wind to the Eastward. Nothing in sight of any consequences after part much the same Tacked ship at 1 1/2 P.M.

Lat by Obs 27.29 N.
Long by Chs 154.40 W.

Sunday Oct 8th 1843

Commenced with strong breezes from E. S. E. steering full and by. Weather all sail set. After part calm and cloudy.

Lat by Obs 26.45 North
