to ends this 24 hours Lat by Obs 41:03.5

westward lying to under main and mizen
topsails with a plenty of rain No Obs

Thursday Dec 21st
Throughout these 24 hours strong gales and
squally weather from the Northward lying
to under main and mizen topsails
Lat by Obs 41:38.5

Friday Dec 22nd
Throughout these 24 hours more moderate with
squalls of rain saw fin backs winds from
the westward heading from N.W. to N.
Lat by Obs 41:52.5
Long by Obs 174:9

Saturday Dec 23rd
Throughout these 24 hours pleasant weather
from the N.W. to N.E. heading to
the westward saw black fish
Lat by Obs 41:44.5

Remains in with fine weather and pleasant
ship heading to the westward with all
