Long by Obs 176: 32.5 E

Tuesday June 15th
Comes in with fine weather ship steering by the
Wind to southward. At daylight made sail Island
later part sunset
Lat by Obs 2: 24.5
Long by Obs 176: 08 E

Wednesday June 16th
Comes in with pleasant weather ship steering by
the wind. At daylight makes Island in sight
later part sunset. At 3 P.M. made sail
Island bearing N.E. At sundown left two on
the wind so ends with fine weather
Saw nothing in the whole line. Lat by Obs 2: 54.5
Long by Obs 176: 18 E

Thursday June 17th
Comes in with fine breeze from the Westward
ship steering by the wind to southward. At 6 P.M.
bearing Island in sight. At 9 P.M. saw whales
and land the North. Did not get one. 20 Baird
Whales so ends with one ship in sight upon it
the Williams halibut. Lat by Obs 2: 21.5

Friday June 18th
First part still so comes in pleasant weather
ship steering by the wind to southward. At daylight
made sail Island bearing N.E. At 6 P.M.
the Williams came. Whales seen. Did not get one.
for late. Comes next the land. Comes with them
At 11 P.M. commenced heaving so ends with three
Williams halibut in sight. Did not see of Whales
Garrison got from some. Did not see one
from my virtuous Whales. Land in sight

Saturday June 19th
Comes in with light breeze from S.E. ship steering
by the wind. Bearing North part squaring. At 6 P.M.
Island bearing N.E. At 8 P.M. saw the Williams
Whales side the snow. No geyser. He gave them
A plenty of fat. Saw nothing west or shore
later part squaring. Did not get one.
Did not shorten sail for the night. Two ships in sight
Lat by Obs

Saturday June 20th
Comes in with thick weather ship steering by the
Wind under short sail. Middle part under. At 11 P.M.
Island bearing N.E. Later part
York J. Bittern ship 16. Whales out 500 hundred
and fifty lbs so ends with two the Williams
halibut in sight. Did not see of Whales.
Shortened sail for the night. Lat by Obs 2: 56.5
Long by Obs 176: 20 E

Sunday June 21st
Comes in with fine weather ship steering by
the Wind to Northward under full sail. Middle part
squaring. At 1 P.M. tucked ship to the southward
and Westward. Later part squaring. Shortened
sail for the night. One ship in sight. Lat by Obs 2: 50.5

Monday June 22nd
All three 24 hours light thick. Did not squaring
ship steering by the wind to the Westward
Shortened sail for the night so ends
Lat by Obs 2: 58.5
Long by Obs 175: 41 E

Tuesday June 23rd
Comes in with light breeze from the Northward
ship steering by the wind to the Westward. Middle
part squaring so ends with fine weather
Lat by Obs 2: 58.5
Long by Obs 174: 24 E
