Tuesday March 18
Throught these 24 hours light air from the Eastward
steering by the wind to the Northward the watch
employed Mocking off was next saw one bill fish
and killed two pigs and lost the cable bar

Wednesday March 19
Throught these 24 hours light air from the
Southward and E. Westward steering E by N
Lat by Obs 19:43

Thursday March 20
First part these 24 hours light air from the
Northward and Eastward steering by the wind
Middle part squaring the topes employed carrying
the boat in Coals with strong breeze
Lat by Obs 20:10.8
Long by Obs 143:5.8

Saturday May 17
Throught this day fine fair changing whales
and trying so Coals

Sunday May 18
Throught this day light breeze from the S.E.
with a thick fog steering by the wind to the
Northward and Eastward finished trying so Coals

Monday May 19
Throught this day calm and a thick
fog strong down so Coals

Tuesday May 20
First part of this day calm in fair saw whales
and galled them with the ship's Mill and later
part strong gale from the S.E. steering to the
Northward and Eastward in a thick rain storm
Left to for the night under a Chest reef main
Trawl and fowl

Wednesday May 21
Throught this day strong breeze from the
S.E. steering East by Compass at 20 N
saw whales but could not stop for them
on account of it being rough and foggy
found for the day hence and looking for
good weather

Thursday May 22
Throught this day fine weather light
breeze from the S.E. steering East with
a light to breeze at 2 N. saw whales and
land the boats and struck the whale once
the boats out of sight to the windward
and they was kept to get some on board
and got dinner and then went again
and galled them and managed
