Saturday June 15th
Came in with light breeze from the westward. At
10 A.M. saw whales. Cook and I went out
at 11 A.M. in fog had to get back to the
ship. At 12 M. saw the boats one ship in sight
Whaling so Cook says finished whaling
turned up 179 And so on. Lat. 54° 30' N
Long 163° 8'

Sunday June 16th
Throughout this day light breeze from W. N. W.
With thick fog strong down saw one whale

Monday June 17th
Came in with light breeze from W. N. W.
thick fog. At 3 P.M. saw half hour of clear
saw whales. Cook struck down. Cook put
so Cook the Cooper impaled setting up sharks

Tuesday June 18th
First part of this day. Came in with calm
and fog. At 10 A.M. saw four whales
Cook struck one took him. Whaling side
Commenced. Killing. At 4 P.M. finished killing
At 5 P.M. heard again struck and drove
so Cook suppose the whale to make 120 lb

Wednesday June 19th
Throughout this day fine weather
At 6 A.M. saw whales. Cook struck
two killed three boats one wreck
The other took Whaling side Commenced
Killing one of the whales I went out
to work on again so Cook finished
down for the night. Killing

Thursday June 20th
Throughout this day much wind blowing. And strong
Lure setting up sharks we find three more whales
One got his large back one his fore arm and ribs
stuck in the other heart had 50 Ends the Carpenter
impaled mending the boats the Cooper setting up
sharks very

Friday June 21st
Throughout this day light breeze from the Eastward
Strongly by the 5 to the wind to the southward north
At 11 A.M. set to the breeze. Whaling side Commenced
And finished. At 1 P.M. saw whales. Cook the
Whaling side of new hauls 13 another out 15 or 16
At 4 P.M. spoke the ship went full toward
how goy go with them so Cook setting up sharks
Lat. 54° 49'

Saturday June 22nd
First part of this day. Came in with strong breeze
from the N. E. And squally. Middle part clear saw
whales. Cook but to see for two ships in sight
Later part fine so Cook setting up sharks

Sunday June 23rd
Throughout this day calm. At 6 A.M. saw
whales. Cook struck two killed three boats
At 6 P.M. took them. Whaling side Commenced
Killing. At 9 P.M. finished down for the night
All hands turned in but the doctor so Cook
Good Luck

Monday June 24th
Throughout this day light breeze from the
Westward and clear. Finished killing suppose
the whales to make 250 lb. Later foggy
so Cook two ships in sight

Tuesday June 25th
Throughout this day fine weather
Westward with thick fog. Killing
