breeze from the N.W. at 12 M. Elms  
Made the main haul of Kummuktha P  
During the haul I saw in company  
with the James steward saw several seals  
but to my surprise I saw one dead whale but  
in good shape. At 1 M. was ship struck  
by seals the Cooper sitting up shook his head.

Thursday July 11

Throughout this day light breeze from all  
points of the compass. At 6 M. saw a dead  
whale to the side of the ship but in  
Government looking the land in sight  
Down the land at 5 M. saw whales  
Several struck two killed one seal sunk from  
the bottom down from the James steward  
in sight catching plenty of whales but  
small suppose the whales that we have  
got to make 25 M. I don't think he will  
make any more than half of that way  
So ends with the ~~main~~ haul in some  
amount.

Friday July 12

Throughout this day calm and pleasant  
wind. No gear will be to keep of the land  
At 7 M. saw whales several struck one he was  
the boat but side of the ship was first to cut  
came on board toward out four fellows  
finished by the day and 25 M. back.  
No could see the Cooper sitting up shook  
the same as usual so ends with seals  
two James two men  
Let by 11 55 20

Saturday July 13

Throughout this day calm and heavy  
Breeze blowing toward evening at 1 M. saw two  
fishbacks that is about 100 the Cooper  
employed mending worn fangs Bought of  
Herd so ends

Sunday July 14

First part of this day comes in heavy with  
light breeze from S.W. Steering to the southward  
With all sail set to the land. Middle part more  
clear. At 2 M. saw one bright whale land  
the four boat struck in passing got steam laid  
to cut the other boat struck and killed he was  
with three men and 40 fathoms of line so ends  
with weather storm boat and the same whale  
this day. I have thought of light about my  
mistaken woman. I hope she is better of to night  
than I feel if she knew how full she would  
puff me. Cases I know this makes the  
11th whale we have sunk this season today  
ought to fill the ship. It looks dark that  
filling the ship this season so ends weather  
about the Carpenter employed mending  
the boat seen at sleep and some conversation  
about the ladies. At home page 10 1/2

Monday July 15

First part of this day comes in with  
light breeze from the S.W. Steering to the  
wind to the southward. Middle part  
part stormy breeze saw fishbacks several  
sail for the night saw the Cooper employed  
mending wraps so ends  
the coat washed his face

Tuesday July 16

Comes in with strong breeze and page  
from the Eastward steering at 1 M. 1/2  
saw one ship at 10 M. came up with  
two speak but I made four more 600 hundred  
the splended of Elyptose saw a french  
the same time looking at 11 M. saw  
Whales several in company we struck three  
Several whales several from me but four  
one parted from the other came on board  
At 2 M. saw whales several in company  
the splended struck two the last one in  
of them separating then so ends mending  
to the mending mending short sail  
for the day I hope better back to mending
