bed At 8 P.M. worked off and out to
get up I if this boat part. I follow in
my mind when he has been before these
nothing more there is plenty of whales moving
All around us but too rough to show
Some sweet some this is lower place like house

Saturday the 10th
Comes in heavy with strong breeze from the Northward
At 6 A.M. saw whales heard killed one took him
Along side but find in Middle Road later part
light weather the grain land in sight being
off saw one ship so good. Weather turned
Drops work stops the whale to make
100 lbs

Sunday the 11th
Throughout this light Air from the North of
the Compass saw two ships so good

Monday the 12th
All this day find weather light air from the south
ward weather steering S by E saw one ship
steering East Lat by the 34° 29'

Tuesday the 13th
Comes in with fine weather light air from the
S.W. steering S by E. After part squally

Wednesday the 14th
Comes in with light Air from the Eastward
steering by the wind to the Northward After part
squally with strong breeze from the Southward
steering East by Compass the watch employed
Scraping down saw one ship steering East
the Captain turned out one Lat by the 34° 50'
steering East moving before Long by the 145 W

Thursday the 15th
Throughout this day strong breeze from the
S.W. steering S by E with all sail set
the watch employed Scraping down the Captain
saw one ship but their boat to day Lat by the 34° 50'
Long by the 145 W
