

Onwards The Arctic May 51

Remarks on Saturday the 3rd

These 24 hours light winds with snow squalls from the N.W. saw four ships on different tacks so ends this day Lat 51° 59' Lon 163° 48'

Remarks on Sunday the 4th

These 24 hours light northerly winds and fine weather 1 ship in sight this ends this day Lat 51° 15' Lon 164° 13'

Remarks on Monday the 5th

These 24 hours light winds from the N. and freezing weather Lat 51° 52' Lon 163° 50'

Remarks on Tuesday the 6th

These 24 hours light winds from the Westward fine weather steering N by E Lat 52° 28' Lon 164° 10'

Remarks on Wednesday the 7th

These 24 hours light airs from the N and Eastward fine weather but freezing 2 ships in sight Lat 53° 15' Lon 164° 15'

Remarks on Thursday the 8th

These 24 hours about the same as yesterday (No obs)

Remarks on Friday the 9th

These 24 hours light winds from N by W ship on the Eastern tack saw 2 right whales lowered 2 boats for them with success saw Behring's Islands saw 5 ships so ends Lat 54° 09' Lon 165° 02'

Remarks on Saturday May the 10th

These 24 hours light winds from the N and Westward 2 boats went on a fishing excursion at an Island to the Eastward of Behring's Island at 2 P.M. the boats returned without any fish Lat 54° 26' Lon 168° 20' E

Remarks on Sunday the 11th

These 24 hours light winds from the Northward the ship on the Eastern tack so ends this day Lat 54° 35' Lon 169° 58'

Remarks on Monday the 12th

These 24 hours the wind from the Northward and a regular snow storm seen 4 ships these 24 hours and 2 right whales Lat 54° 50' Lon 170° 00' E

Remarks on Tuesday the 13th

These 24 hours light winds from the Northward we have had it cold enough to freeze this last 16 days nearly every night and any quantity of snow Lat 55° 17' Lon 170° 20'

Remarks Wednesday the 14th

These 24 hours light wind from the Northward Lat 56° 00' Lon 169° 15'

Remarks on Thursday the 15th

These 24 hours light winds from the Northward ship on the Western tack cold weather and the water very smooth Lat 56° 28' Lon 168° 55'

Remarks on Friday the 16th

These 24 hours light winds from the N.W. and fine weather ship heading N by E under all sail so ends this day Lat 57° 09' Lon 168° 06'
