

Bhearing, Straits July 1851

Remarks on Saturday July the 26th
These 24 hours the wind N.W. & with fog
and rain ship at anchor 18 other ships
in sight at anchor

Remarks on Sunday the 27th
These 24 hours light winds from S.W. & overcast
at 2 o'clock P.M. got the ship under weigh and
sailed out into the straits heading N.E. & several
other ships got under weigh at the same time
left several at anchor

Remarks on Monday the 28th
These 24 light winds from the Northward
and fine weather saw 5 whales going to the North
quick lowered for them without success saw
about 20 ships most of them going to the South
Lat 64.41

Remarks on Tuesday the 29th
These 24 hours strong breeze from the N.W. &
Lat 64.42

Remarks on Wednesday the 30th
First part of these 24 hours a strong breeze
from the N.W. with rain latter part light
winds from the Eastward and a strong
current setting N.E. thick fog sounded
had 13 fathoms of water saw one
ship and rip sacks too numerous
to mention

Remarks on Thursday the 31st
These 24 hours light winds from the N.W.
spoke the Abdim Barker 2 whales this season

Aug 1851

Remarks on Friday the 1st
These 24 hours light winds from the N.W. with
fog and rain

Remarks on Saturday the 2nd
These 24 for the most part of the time foggy
at 11 A.M. anchored with a small anchor in 26 fathoms
of water off St. Lawrence Bay the land 15 miles dist
Lat 65.27

Remarks on Sunday the 3rd
These 24 hours light winds from the East
and foggy at 10 A.M. got under weigh

Remarks on Monday the 4th
These 24 hours light verable winds clear part of
the time this morning the ship between Cape East
and the Dimides Islands both in sight saw several
Whales at 6 P.M. spoke the Caravan of Wall River
one whale this season ten ships in sight
Lat 66.10

Remarks on Tuesday the 5th
These 24 hours a wet nasty time to make
the best of it

Remarks on Wednesday the 6th
These 24 hours a strong from the N.W. and first
part thick weather latter part fine at 5 A.M. veered
ship heading S.W. towards the land saw only
quantity of Whales and ice saw several ships
Lat 66.47
