Remarks on Board Wednesday Jan 10th
This 24 hours commences with Light Breezes
from SE with Pleasant Weather Ship heading
SE by E. at 3 discovered a hulk in the
Bay. at 5 set the Toppingails and Cep
of Mast for the Ab. of Grand

Latter at 7 saw a School of Whales at 9 lowered
the Boats at 11 struck and killed 15
11 Ends this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Thursday Jan 11th
This 24 hours commences with Light Breezes
from the East with Pleasant Weather
at 1 took the Whales along side and Cut
them in all but the Leads then the
left along side for the night

Latter Pleasant Weather
at 6 hove in the heads and at 10 commenced
Hoisting Ship heading W

This 24 hours commences with moderate
Breezes Ship heading W. Wind from the
North. Employed Hoisting
