This 24 hours Commences with Strong
Breezes from SE with Pleasant Weather
Ship heading E & S. saw a porpoise

Middle Part took in sail

Latter made Sail
Ship heading E & S. employed
Bracking out to find the Leak
at 11 found it in the fore hole
10 Ends there 24 hours
(a small Hole in the seam)
