Remarks on Board Friday January 31st 1845
This 24 hours Commences with a Gale from
S.W. with Cloudy Weather Ship heading W by N
at 4 set the Foretop sail Double Reefed
Middle Part at 7 wore Ship to
the S.S.E. ship began to leak 600 strokes per hour
at 8 the wind from
South wore Ship again Ship heading
W by N

Latter more moderate at
9 made all sail Ship heading W by S
at 10 sail in light

This 24 hours Commences with moderate
Breezes from South with Pleasant Weather
Course W by S
Breezes from Middle Part Strong
all sail set

Remarks on Board Sunday the 2nd
This 24 hours Commences with Strong
Breezes from East with Cloudy Weather
Course W. saw Blackfish

Middle Part at 12 Calm
at 1 Strong Breezes from West
Ship heading S by N

Latter at 7 wind from N by W
Tacked Ship Ship heading NW by N

Lat 33.59 Long 27.45

Remarks on Board Monday February 3rd
This 24 hours Commences with Strong
Breezes from S by N with Pleasant
Weather Ship heading S by N at 2 saw
the Land at 3 Tacked Ship at
4 a Gale from N by W took in all
sail but Close reefed Topsails and
Foresail

Middle Part at 8 took in the
Foresail at 10 the wind shifted to
the S by N where Ship to the West
Ship Leaking 1000 strokes per hour

Latter moderate Breezes from S by N
Course West made all sail at
7 found the Leak but could not
get at it to stop it
Employed fitting a Stryangle
fore the Pumps 10 Ends this 24 hours

at 5 put it up
