Remarks on Board Saturday April the 5th. A.D. 1855
This 24 hours Commences with Moderate Breezes from S.W., attended with Pleasant Weather. Course N.W. at 6 saw a Ship steering to the S.E.

Middle Part Strong Breezes from S.W. Course N.W. at 2 took in the Foretopgallentails. Latter Part Strong Breezes and Squally Weather. saw a Ship steering to the Eastward. So Ends these 24 hours

Latitude 35.07 N Longitude 68.42 W

Remarks on Board Sunday April the 6th
This 24 hours Commences with Strong Breezes from N.W. with Squally Weather Course N by W. at 4 took in the Main topgallentails

Middle Part Squally Rainy Weather with Thunder and Lightning

Latter Part Strong Breezes from S.W. with Squally Weather at 7 set the Foretopgallentails. Course N.W. by E. at noon took in the Foretopgallentails. So Ends these 24 hours

Latitude 36.23 N Longitude 69.36 W

Remarks on Board Monday April the 7th
This 24 hours Commences with Strong Breezes from West with Squally Weather. Course S.W. by W. at 4 wind shifted to the North west Ship to the Westward at 2 double Reefed the Topsails and furlled the Gib and mainsail

Middle Part at 8 Moderate set all Sails

Latter Light Breezes from North Ship heading N.E. at 11 wind from N.W. backed Ship Ship heading N.W. So Ends these 24 hours

Remarks on Board Tuesday April the 8th
This 24 hours Commences with Light Breezes from West with Pleasant Weather Course N.W.

Middle Part Squally at 3 wind from N.W. took in the Gib and mainsail and double Reefed the Topsails

Latter Part Strong Breezes from N.W. Ship heading N.E. So Ends these 24 hours

Lat 28.09 Long 69.53

Remarks on Board Wednesday April the 9th
This 24 hours Commences with Moderate Gale from N.W. with Squally Weather. at 2 Close Reefed the Foretopgallentails at 4 heavy Gale from N.W. by W. furlled the Topsails and Foresail hove two under Foretopmast staysail Fore spences and double Reefed the Foresail Ship heading N by E

Middle Part do at 5 the S Boat got stove by a Sea. had some Snow

Latter Part at 8 set the main Topgallentails Close Reefed and Foresail. So Ends these 24 hours

Lat 38.46 Long 67.58 W

Remarks on Board Thursday the 10th
This 24 hours Commences with Moderate Gale from N.W. with Squally Weather Ship heading N.E. at 2 set the Foretopgallentails Close Reefed. at 6 Let one Reef out the Topsails

Middle Part at 10 Let the Reefs out the Topsails and set the Gib and mainsail

Latter Strong Breezes from N.W. with Pleasant Weather Course N.W. So Ends these 24 hours
