Wednesday First part of this day commences strong breezes under
July 24th short sail wind from the S.W. steering course S.E. by S
and very rugged middle part moderate gales at 2 o'clock
receded the topsails latter part the same saw great
quantities of gulf weed so ends this day Lat 35° 28' N Long 41° 30' W

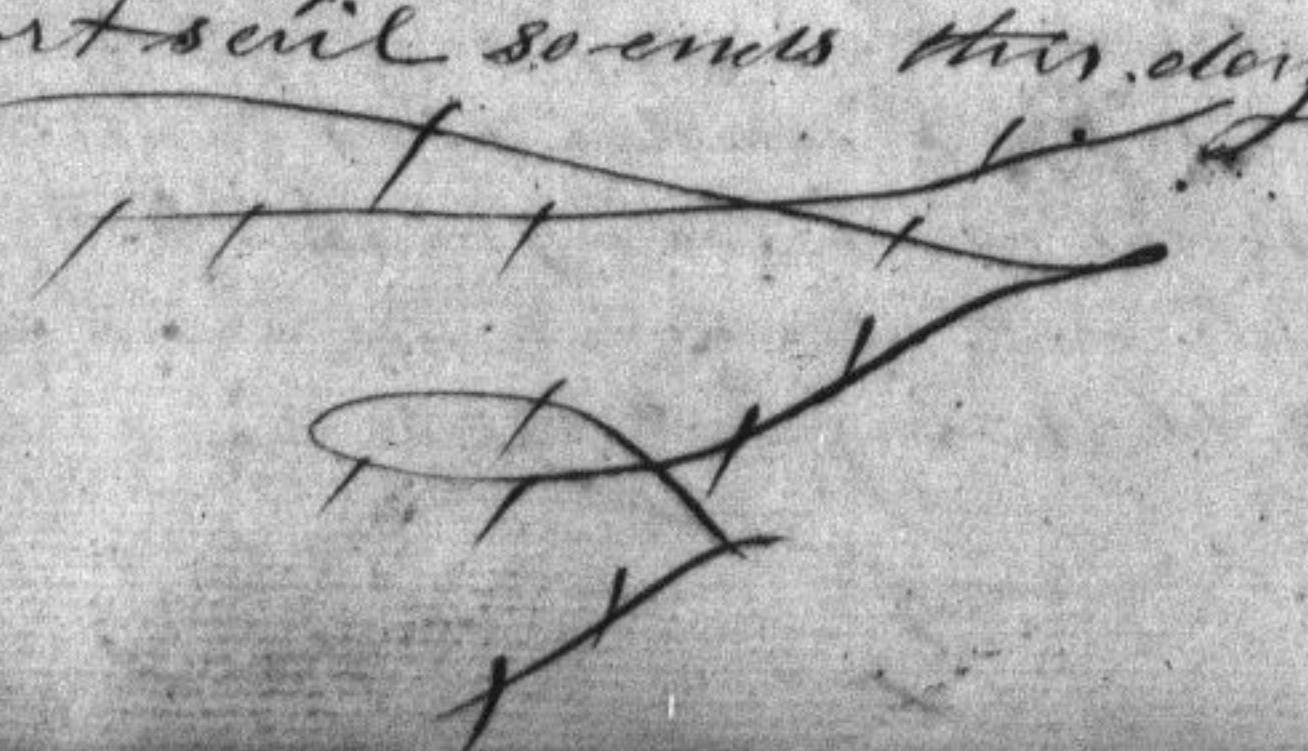
Thursday First part of this day commences moderate gales from
July 25th the S.W. at 1 P.M. took in fore sail and hauled to the
wind S.E. at 6 do took in fore top sail middle part rain
and squally latter part more moderate so for topsails
saw school of Blackfish and porpoises so ends this day Lat 35° 42' N Long 42° 34' W

Friday This day commences moderate breezes and very rugged
July 26th wind from W. heading by the wind S.W. at 4 P.M. he
her off S.E. and set the foresail middle part fine
schock reefs out of the topsails latter part set top
gallantsails so ends this day steering course S.E. wind
from the W. Lat 35° 42' N Long 50° 2' W

Saturday This day comes in with moderate breezes and
July 27th fine pleasant weather steering course S.E. wind from
the W. at 4 P.M. lowered the boats for exercising the
crew at 8 do took in top gallantsails middle part
and latter the same so ends this day Lat 36° 43' N Long 47° 45' W

Sunday This day commences strong breezes and fine pleasant
July 28th weather steering course S.E. wind from the W. at 10
down shortened sail and set quarter roaches two on
on the sick list and have been for this last week
middle and latter part the same at daylight set
main sail and gib so ends this day Lat 35° 35' N Long 46° 11' W

Monday This day commences strong breezes and clear weather steering
July 29th course S.E. under double reefed topsails at sundown shortened
sail and hauled to the wind I saw a ship steering or
middle part the same latter part steering course S.E.
under double topsails saw two sail she lying to
under short sail so ends this day Lat 34° 20' N Long 49° 11' W

First part of this 24 hours commences strong breezes
from the S.W. steering course S.E. at 2 P.M. spoke Brig
John of Mattapovett 8 months out then had seen whales
but once the voyage at sundown shortened sail
hauled to the wind I saw middle part fine latter part
at day light made sail heading by the wind S
so ends this day Lat 34° 01' Long 43° 23' W

Monday First part of this day comes in with moderate
July 30th breezes from W.S.W. heading by the wind I saw grampus
all hands employed in fitting flying jib gear and jib
Topsail middle and latter part fine employed in rigging
flying jib boom so ends this day Lat 33° 04' Long 52° 34' W

Tuesday First part of this day commences light winds from
July 31st W.S.W. heading by the wind I saw grampus at sun
down shortened sail middle part fine latter part
at day light made all sail had shower of rain at 10
tackled ships to the S.W. wind from the W. so ends this
day Lat 32° 30' N Long 41° 53' W

Wednesday First part of this day comes in with light winds and
July 1st fine pleasant weather heading by the wind W. at 8
wind from the W. saw cow fish at 3 P.M. set fly
ing jib at sundown shortened sail middle part fine
latter part day light made sail and all hands employ
ed in sprouting potatoes so ends this day heading
by the wind W. by N Lat 33° 11' N Long 41° 30' W

Thursday First part of this day comes in with light winds from
July 2nd the W. by N heading by the wind at 1 P.M. saw several small
batches of sundown shortened sail middle part at 2 o'clock
night had shower of rain wind hauled to the W.S.W.
heading W. latter part the same so ends this day Lat 33° 11' N Long 41° 30' W

Friday First part of this day commences light winds and fine clear
July 3rd weather heading W. wind from W.S.W. at sunset shortened
sail as usual middle part wind from the S.W. heading
W. by N latter part at daylight made all sail and
kept her off by N saw nothing worth remarking so
ends this day Lat 35° 30' N Long 42° 41' W
