

Remarks on board Bark Geoman cruising for Sp

Sunday First part of this day commences strong breezes from the N E heading by the wind E S E saw two humpbacks and part squall. latter part at 7 P M tacked ship to the N so ends this day Lat 36° 43' N Long 38° 13' W

Monday First part of this day commences strong breezes from the E heading by the wind N E E saw nothing worth remark middle part moderate latter part the same wind from the E S E heading N E saw one sail steering to westward so ends this day Lat 38° 17' N Long 38° 37' W

Tuesday First part of this day commences light winds from the E S E heading N E saw one sail steering on the wind N E and saw shoal of low fish middle part the same latter part at daylight made all sail head N E and saw humpbacks and porpoises so ends this day employed in ships duty Lat 38° 57' N Long 38° 41' W

Wednesday First part of this day commences light winds from the E S E heading by the N E at 4 P M wind hauled to the S W steering on course E or E at sundown took in sail for the night saw porpoises middle and latter part the same saw two sail steering S wind from S W so ends this day Lat 38° 39' N Long 38° 31' W

Thursday First part of this day commences strong breezes from the N steering on course E or E saw two humpbacks and a shoal of porpoises middle and latter part under double reefed topsails saw one sail steering on a wind S E so ends this day Lat 40° 05' N Long 35° 08' W

Friday First part of this day commences strong breezes from S W steering on course E saw breaches ahead at sundown shortened sail middle part squall latter part the same saw three sail steering N E so ends this day Lat 41° 14' N Long 35° 08' W

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Saturday Commences strong breezes from the S W and gradually heading by the wind S E employed in repairing Foresail at 3 P M spoke Ship Levi Starbuck of Nantucket at 5 P M took in gib & main sail and close reefed the topsails middle part the same latter part at 7 P M set the spanker and fore experiences so ends this day Lat 40° 24' N

Sunday Commences moderate gales from the N heading by the wind S W and a very heavy sea a running saw a shoal of porpoises middle moderate latter part at daylight made all sail steering course N E saw shoal of porpoises so ends this day employed in ships duty Lat 40° 47' N Long 35° 06' W

Monday Commences light winds from S W steering on course N E and thick cloudy weather middle part squall latter part broke out the hatchways for water & vinegar so ends this day no obs

Tuesday This day commences moderate breezes from the S W steering on course E by N saw several breaches at sundown shortened sail steering same course middle part the same latter part saw several vessels steering on a wind supposed them to be whalers so ends this day Lat

Wednesday This day commences strong breezes from the N steering on course E at 2 P M spoke Bark Fairy of Providence Town 5 months out 280 lbs sperm Capt went aboard at 8 P M returned and took in sail and hauled to the wind saw shoal of sperm humpbacks middle the same latter part saw two more sail so ends this day employed in ships duty Lat 41° 19' N Long 31° 08' W

Thursday This day commences moderate breezes from the N steering by the wind N S W in company with the Fairy middle part the same latter part saw shoal of humpbacks at 7 P M tacked ship to the N so ends this day employed in ships duty Lat 41° 10' N Long 31° 25' W
