

Remarks on board Bark Yeoman Cruising for

Friday First part of this day commences light winds from the N. at 2 P.M. took the ship to the N. S. M. employed in ships duty at sundown shortened sail and from the N. heading up at N. M. middle part the same latter part saw Grampuses so ends this day employed in making a Potatoes peris Lat 40° 13' N

Saturday First part of this day comes in with moderate breezes from the N. heading by the wind N. M. saw several large breaches to homeward at sundown shortened sail for the night middle part the same latter part saw nothing employed in working to windward and building Potatoes peris Lat 40° 13' N Long 31° 58' W

Sunday First part of this day commences moderate breeze from the N. heading by the wind N. M. saw nothing worth remarking employed in making a Potatoes peris middle part squally latter strong breezes and double reefed topsails and courses so ends this day Lat 40° 25' N Long 32° 56' W

Monday First part of this day comes in with strong and smooth breeze from the N. heading by the wind N. M. saw nothing worth remarking middle part moderate latter part the same at 11 A.M. saw shoal of Whales so ends this day Lat 40° 30' N Long 33° 15' W

Tuesday First part of this day comes in with light winds from the N. at 1 P.M. lowered the boats for whale at 4 took one along side middle part set quarter watched latter cutting in the whale blowing moderate gale from the N. E. so ends this day Lat 41° 10' N Long 33° 58'

Wednesday First part of this day comes in with moderate gales from the N. heading by the wind N. E. all hands employed in the whale at 5 P.M. case ropes parted and lost the case middle part raining at 4 A.M. commenced boiling latter part the same at 4 A.M. wore ship to the S. so ends this day Lat 41° 10' N Long 33° 30'

Whales in North Atlantic Ocean of 1841

First part of this day commences moderate gales from the N. heading by the wind N. E. all hands employed in boiling middle part fine and moderate latter part the same at 4 A.M. finished boiling and washed off the decks so ends this day Lat 40° 30' N Long 34° 30' W

Thursday First part of this day comes in with light winds from the N. steering course N. E. saw shoal of Blackfish lowered but did not get part middle part the same latter part wind from the N. heading by the wind S. W. at 6 A.M. commenced stowing down the oil saw breaches so ends this day Lat 40° 30' N Long 34° 30' W

Friday First part of this day commences moderate breeze from the N. heading by the wind S. W. all hands employed in stowing down the oil saw Grampuses at sundown shortened sail for the night middle and latter part the same at 10 A.M. finished stowing so ends this day Lat 40° 30' N Long 34° 30' W

Saturday First part of this day comes in with light winds from the N. steering course N. E. at sundown hauled up the main yard and hauled to the wind S. W. middle part had a squall of wind and rain from the N. with thunder and lightning latter part fine wind hauled to the N. steering course N. E. saw Grampuses and Porpoises so ends this day employed in washing Lat 40° 30' N Long 33° 23' W

Sunday First part of this day comes in with moderate breezes from the N. steering course N. E. saw Grampuses and Porpoises and one sail steering to Eastward at sundown hauled to wind N. E. shortened sail middle and latter part under short sail heading N. E. so ends this day Long by thro 33° 30' W by Lunar Obs 35° 20' W Lat 40° 30' N
